SUMMARY:

Ron Trachtenberg, Randall Milbrath, and Eric Nielsen, all representing St. Paul's Catholic Center, registered in support. Trachtenberg stated that the project has approval for a 6-story building but they are now reducing the height to 5-stories to work with the budget. Milbrath stated that they adjusted the design proportionally and showed a perspective of the revised St. Paul's project next to the Pres House.
