Our application for Community eligibility at 3 more schools has been approved for the 2015-16 school year. All students at Lindberg, Sandburg, and Hawthorne will be eligible for breakfast and lunch each school day.

Enrollment for the 2015-16 school year stared on August 4, 2015. We have 7,834 students who have been direct certified for meal benefits. We will be aggressively tackling the application & approval process over the next several weeks to insure that our students receive the meal benefits they are eligible for.

We will be adding a new menu feature this fall for our customers. The Nutrislice menu system will provide nutritional information and pictures of the menu items. This will be a great tool for nutrition education and highlighting locally produced food. There is also a phone App to make this information more accessible to families. We will be introducing the Nutrislice system with our elementary menu this fall.
