Your two-lot certified survey of property located at 9603 Paragon Street, Section 21, Township 7N, Range 8E, City of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin, is hereby **conditionally approved**. The property is zoned IL (Industrial Limited District). The conditions of approval from the reviewing agencies to be satisfied prior to final approval and recording of the CSM are:

Please contact Tim Troester of the City Engineering Division at 267-1995 if you have questions regarding the following nine (9) items:

- 1. The applicant shall complete a drainage agreement between the affected lots to address the shared drainage. That agreement shall be reviewed and approved by the City Engineer.
- 2. The construction of this project will require the applicant shall enter into a City / Developer agreement for the required infrastructure improvements. The applicant shall contact City Engineering to schedule the development of the plans and the agreement. The City Engineer will not sign off on this project without the agreement executed by the developer. Obtaining a developer's agreement generally takes approximately 4-6 weeks, minimum. (MGO 16.23(9)c)
- 3. The developer shall construct public sanitary sewer, storm sewer, and drainage improvements as necessary to serve the lots within the plat/csm. (MGO 16.23(9)(d))
- 4. All outstanding Madison Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD) charges are due and payable prior to Engineering sign-off, unless otherwise collected with a Developer's / Subdivision Contract. Contact Mark Moder (608-261-9250) to obtain the final MMSD billing a minimum of two (2) working days prior to requesting City Engineering signoff. (MGO 16.23(9)(d)(4)
- 5. All outstanding City of Madison sanitary sewer connection charges are due and payable prior to Engineering sign-off, unless otherwise collected with a Developer's / Subdivision Contract. This property is subject to Sanitary Connection charges for the Elderberry Neighborhood Sanitary Sewer Improvement Impact Fee District.

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- 6. The lots within this certified survey map are inter-dependent upon one another for storm water runoff conveyance, and/or a private drainage system exists for the entire site an agreement shall be provided for the rights and responsibilities of all lot owners. Said agreement shall be reviewed and placed on file by the City Engineer, referenced on the certified survey map and recorded at the Dane Co Register of Deeds. (POLICY)
- 7. A minimum of two (2) working days prior to requesting City Engineering signoff on the plat/csm the applicant shall contact either Tim Troester at 261-1995 (ttroester@cityofmadison.com) or Brenda Stanley at 608-261-9127 (bstanley@cityofmadison.com) to obtain the final stormwater utility charges that are due and payable prior to sub-division of the properties. The stormwater utility charges (as all utility charges) are due for the previous months of service. All charges shall be cleared prior to the land division (and subsequent obsolesces of the existing parcel). (POLICY)
- 8. This site appears to disturb over one (1) acre of land and requires a permit from the WDNR for stormwater management and erosion control. The City of Madison has been required by the WDNR to review projects for compliance with NR216 and NR-151 however a separate permit submittal is still required to the WDNR for this work. The City of Madison cannot issue our permit until concurrence is obtained from the WDNR via their NOI or WRAPP permit process. Contact Eric Rortvedt at 273-5612 of the WDNR to discuss this requirement. - 9. The developer shall construct Madison Standard street and sidewalk improvements for all streets within the plat/csm. (MGO 16.23(9)(d)6)

Please contact Jeff Quamme of the Mapping Section of the City Engineering Division at 266-4097 if you have questions regarding the following eight (8) items.

- 10. The Public Water Main Easement required by Kelly Miess of the Madison Water Utility shall be added and dimensioned on the CSM. The required easement language that has been provided shall also be added to the CSM.
- 11. The temporary turnaround easement required by Lisa Coleman of the City of Madison Engineering Dept. shall be added and dimensioned on the CSM. the required easement language that has been provided shall also be added to the CSM.
- 12. Add a note to the Certified Survey Map that lands within this CSM are subject to Declaration of Conditions, Covenants and Restrictions per Doc No.'s 5101073, 5101075, 5101076 and 5101077.
- 13. This land division is to permit a phased development as required by Comment 5 of the Conditional Use Approval letter of June 15, 2015.
- 14. Wisconsin Administrative Code A-E 7.08 identifies when Public Land System (PLS) tie sheets must be filed with the Dane County Surveyor's office. The Developer's Surveyor and/or Applicant must submit copies of required tie sheets or monument condition reports for all monuments, including center of sections of record, used in this survey, to Jeff Quamme, City Engineering (<u>irquamme@cityofmadison.com</u>). If a new tie sheet is not required under A-E 7.08, Engineering requests a copy of the latest tie sheet on record with Dane County Surveyor's office and shall be

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attached to a signed and sealed monument condition report. The Applicant shall identify monument types on all PLS corners included on the Plat or CSM. Note: Land tie to two PLS corners required.

- 15. The applicant shall submit to Jeff Quamme, prior to Engineering sign-off of the subject CSM, one (1) digital CADD drawing and one (1) signed copy of the final plat/CSM to the Mapping/GIS Section of the Engineering Division either as hard copy or Adobe pdf format. The digital CADD file shall be submitted in the WISDOT County Coordinate System, Dane County Zone datum in either Auto CAD Version compatible with MicroStation Version V8i, MicroStation Version V8i or older or Universal DXF Formats. The digital CADD file(s) shall contain the minimum of the items stated below, each on a separate layer name/level number. All line work shall be void of gaps and overlaps that would cause any parcel, street or easement to not properly close. All line work orientation and geometrics shall match the dimensioning as labeled on the final recorded plat:
 - a. Right-of-Way lines (public and private)
 - b. Lot lines
 - c. Lot numbers
 - d. Lot/Plat dimensions
 - e. Street names
 - f. Easement lines (i.e. street, sanitary, storm (including wetland & floodplain boundaries) water, pedestrian/bike/walkway, or any public and/or private interest easement except local service for Cable TV, gas, electric and fiber optics). NOTE: This Transmittal is a separate requirement from the required Engineering Streets Section for design purposes. The Developer/Surveyor shall submit new updated final plat, electronic data and a written notification to Engineering Mapping for any changes to the plat which occur subsequent to any original submittal of data and prior to final sign off.
- 16. Prior to Engineering final sign-off by main office for Plats or Certified Survey Maps (CSM), the final Plat or CSM must be submitted to Engineering Division Surveyor / Land Records Coordinator for final technical review and approval. This submittal must occur a minimum of two working days prior to final Engineering Division sign-off. Electronic mail submittal of the FINAL Plat or CSM in PDF form is preferred. - 17. The existing public stormwater drainage easement has been recorded as Doc. No. 5172700 and shall be added to the CSM.

- 18. Place the following not on the face of the CSM: LOTS/BUILDINGS WITHIN THIS SUBDIVISION/DEVELOPMENT ARE SUBJECT TO IMPACT FEES THAT ARE DUE AND PAYABLE AT THE TIME BUILDING PERMIT(S) ARE ISSUED.

20. This property is not in a wellhead protection district. All wells located on this property shall be abandoned if no valid well operation permit has been obtained from the Madison Water Utility. The Water Utility will not need to sign off the final plans, and will not need a copy of the approved plans.

- 21. Prior to requesting approval sign-off, executed signature block certifications shall be included for all parties of interest, pursuant to Wis. Stats. 236.21(2)(a). All signatory parties shall provide documentation that proves said signatories have legal authority to sign the Owner's Certificate. The title of each certificate shall be consistent with the ownership interest reported in the most recent title report.
- 22. There are no current mortgages of record; however, if mortgagees are secured prior to CSM approval, a certificate of consent shall be included following the Owner's Certificate and executed prior to CSM approval sign-off.
- 23. Address the following certificate and consent requirements:
 - a. All ownership consents and certifications for the subject lands shall conform to Wis. Stats. 236.21(2) and 236.29 by including the language ...surveyed, divided, mapped and dedicated....
 - b. Include a certificate for the Register of Deeds for the CSM recording info.
 - c. Change the name of the Secretary of the Plan Commission in the City of Madison Plan Commission Certificate to Natalie Erdman.
- 24. As of October 1, 2015, the real estate taxes are paid for the subject property. If the CSM is not approved and recorded prior to the annual tax bill distribution, taxes shall be paid in full prior to CSM sign-off by the Office of Real Estate Services per 236.21(3) Wis. Stats. and 16.23(5)(g)(1) Madison General Ordinances.
- 25. As of October 1, 2015, special assessments are reported for the lands within the CSM boundary. All known special assessments are due and payable prior to CSM approval sign-off pursuant to Ordinance Enactment No. ORD-08-00094, ID No. 10847, Enactment Date 8/23/2008.
- 26. Please coordinate with Tim Troester (608-267-1995) or Brenda Stanley (608-261-9127) in the City Engineering Division to obtain any outstanding storm water management fees from the City of Madison Water Utility. Receipts for the payment of the prorated fee shall be presented prior to CSM approval sign-off.
- 27. Pursuant to Madison City Ordinance Section 16.23(5)(g)(4), the owner shall furnish an updated title report to the City's Office of Real Estate Services, as well as the survey firm preparing the proposed CSM. The report shall search the period subsequent to the date of the initial title report (7-13-15) submitted with the CSM application and include all associated documents that have been recorded since the initial title report. Surveyor shall update the CSM with the most recent information reported in the title update.

- 28. Revise the CSM as follows:
 - a. Include Notes describing the various Declarations by Document Number.
 - b. If possible, depict WPL easement per Doc. No. 487866, or provide a Note describing said easement if not traceable.
 - c. Fill in the labels for the stormwater drainage easement on Sheets 2 & 3 with Document No. 5172700.
 - d. Replace the word subdivision with CSM in the third bullet point under general notes on Sheet 1.
 - e. Replace the word plat with CSM in the forth bullet point under general notes on Sheet 1.
 - f. Record the easements for utility and drainage rights of way that are proposed/depicted on the CSM.
 - g. If all parties of interest agree that certain easements from prior plats or CSM's of record are no longer necessary, the release documents for said easements shall be recorded prior to CSM approval sign-off, with the recording information for the release included as a Note on the proposed CSM.

Specific questions regarding the comments or conditions contained in this letter should be directed to the commenting agency.

A resolution approving the CSM and authorizing the City to sign it and any other documents related to the proposed land division were approved by the Common Council on <u>October 6, 2015</u>.

As soon as the comments and conditions have been satisfied as verified with a completed affidavit form (attached), the original along with the revised Certified Survey Map, with all signatures and approvals from the reviewing agencies, shall be brought to this office for final signoff. You or your client may then record the certified survey at the Dane County Register of Deeds. For information on recording procedures and fees, contact the Register of Deeds at 266-4141.

Prior to City Engineering final sign-off by the main office of the CSM, the final CSM shall be submitted to the Engineering Division Surveyor/ Land Records Coordinator for final technical review and approval. This submittal must occur a minimum of two working days prior to final Engineering Division signoff. E-mail submittal of the final CSM in PDF form is preferred. Transmit to <u>jrquamme@cityofmadison.com</u>.

The owner shall furnish to the Office of Real Estate Services and the survey firm preparing the CSM an updated title report covering the period between the date of the initial title report and the date when final signoff is requested. The surveyor shall update the CSM with the most recent information reported in the title update.

Upon acceptance and recording of the Certified Survey Map by the Dane County Register of Deeds, please transfer the recorded volume, document number, and page numbers to the copies and forward a copy to this office for our records. The original survey map with the recording information is permanently kept on file in the Dane County Register of Deeds Office. A copy of the recorded document can be obtained from the Register of Deeds Office, Room 110, City-County Building or the Real Estate Office in the Madison Department of Planning and Development.

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Any appeal from this action, including the conditions of approval, must be filed with the Circuit Court within 30 days from the date of this letter. The approval of this CSM shall be null and void if not recorded in twelve (12) months from the date of the approving resolution or this letter, whichever is later.
