## **SUMMARY:**

Staff explained that the Landmarks Commission approved the Certificate of Appropriateness for the demolition of the annex in August and that the approval was contingent on having all other land use approvals for the adjacent new development in place. The City is interested in removing the annex regardless of the adjacent development and the item was placed on the agenda to remove the condition of approval. Since that time, the adjacent development has stopped. The City will come before the Commission with the full Municipal Building Restoration proposal in the late winter/early spring and the motion language for the annex demolition can be discussed as part of that larger project at that time.

The Applicant requested indefinite referral.
