

## SAFETY/SECURITY PLAN

Using the last five years exemplary event successes as our guide, we will once again enlist a team of 15-20 volunteers as well as our regular staff members to monitor traffic flow, check ID's and issue wristbands and help with continual trash pick-up and final street reclamation. We will again use city provided trash receptacles, 9 for trash and 3 for recyclables.

We will coordinate efforts with the Madison Police Department as required as well as with the Madison Fire Department in regards to any/all food preparation that might be considered moving forward.

Monitors and clearly identified entrances will be stationed at both ends of King street to check ID's and issue wristbands as well as collect donations.

Signage will be affixed at both entrances instructing attendees that no liquor can be taken from the designated street area when exiting.

\*\*Additionally stage staffing and production support will assist in maintaining an acceptable presence and permit compliance of all performers as well as attendees on street and maintain stage area as "off limits" to anyone not specifically hired/scheduled by WOOF'S as entertainment.

STREET USE COMITTE MEMBERS, as you know, Jason and I created WOOF'S KING STREET PRIDE in 2011, initially to offer an alternative outlet for Madison's LGBT community to celebrate LGBT PRIDE here in Madison. Happily, as we plan for our fifth consecutive event, many things have remained the same while there have been significant changes underway as well. Tentatively scheduled again this year for Saturday August 6th., WOOF'S will once again create a street fair atmosphere with community outreach and awareness offerings, food and beverages as well as staging for music and related local acts to perform and entertain. Capitalizing on the success of our last 4 years events we will strive to create a similar event with subtle changes that will accommodate additional people, create an increased visibility and variety of community based outreach areas and enhance the activities on the street allowing attendees to spend more time at the event. The event is planned for the 100 block of King St. and is scheduled for Saturday August 6th from 4:00 PM until midnight! Once again, our charitable beneficiary is OUTREACH, Inc. We are excited to partner with them as they will once again be organizing and facilitating Madison's Pride March and Rally as the culmination of Madison's PRIDE WEEK on Sunday August 7th-based on last years success of this Madison LGBT community tradition we expect another successful event. We know that this event will once again bring a diverse and eclectic mix of local and visiting attendees, all looking to enjoy and explore what downtown Madison and specifically King street has to offer. Last year's event drew over 1200 local and visiting individuals to our street, enriching both the community and the business atmosphere on King Street. We raised over \$3000 for the various charities we sponsored and continue to strive towards recognition of The First Settlement district and specifically King Street as a destination for a large part of our community who tend to shy away from downtown activities because of mis-conceptions about access and parking.

We welcome your support and participation in our event in any way that you might deem appropriate, and if nothing else, hope to see you among the crowds celebrating an event which has become a mainstay for our community. We have once again reached out to our neighbors, inviting them to participate, and have had several accept the invitation already this year.
