



The drawings shall include, but are not limited to, a description of existing site conditions and natural features, delineation of all public and private utilities that serve the site (denote field located versus record drawings), the general layout of the proposed subdivision, the dimensions of lots and outlots, widths of existing and proposed rights of way, topographic information, and any other information necessary for the review of the proposed subdivision. For Final Plats, sixteen (16) copies of the drawing are required to be submitted. The final plat shall be drawn 	
		 to the specifications of Section 236.20 of the Wisconsin Statutes. For <u>Certified Survey Maps (CSM)</u>, sixteen (16) copies of the drawing are required. The drawings shall include all of the information set forth in Sections 16.23(7)(a)&(d) of the Madison General Ordinances, including existing site conditions, the nature of the proposed division and any other necessary data.
