## <u>Agencies</u>

**IMLS** Institute of Museum and Library Services, federal agency that administers LSTA **LSTA** Library Services and Technology Act, the major federal library funding law and grant program. Currently funds \$75,000 annually to SCLS Delivery Services. COLAND Council on Library and Network Development, advisory council to the Governor of Wisconsin, **DPI** and the Wisconsin state legislature on libraries and information services. **DPI** Department of Public Instruction, State of Wisconsin **DLT** Division for Libraries and Technology Public Library Development Team (no acronym) RLLL Resources for Libraries and Lifelong Learning **SCLS** South Central Library System, one of 17 agencies in Wisconsin that provides support to public libraries through the state aid received annually from DPI. Library Associations, Groups, Vendors, Schools **ALA** American Library Association, the national professional organization for all types of libraries. PLA Public Library Association, a division of ALA for public libraries WLA Wisconsin Library Association, the state professional organization for all types of libraries WAPL Wisconsin Association of Public Libraries, a division of WLA for public libraries SRLAAW System and Resource Library Administrators' Association of Wisconsin is composed of administrators from all seventeen Wisconsin Public Library Systems and the library directors of the resource libraries from each system. SRLAAW meets approximately four times per year to deal with statewide legislative and policy issues that impact public library service in Wisconsin. WPLC Wisconsin Public Library Consortium is an organization where library systems can partner on projects that move libraries forward through experimentation, research and development. Responsible for statewide OverDrive downloadable book service. WiLS (formerly Wisconsin Library Services) is a non-profit membership organization that facilitates collaborative projects and services to advance library service, primarily in the state of Wisconsin. OCLC (formerly Online Computer Library Center) (formerly Ohio College Library Center) is a not for profit company that produces an international bibliographic utility used by libraries of all types for cataloging information, interlibrary loan and other services. Products include Worldcat, FirstSearch,

University of Wisconsin's graduate School of Library and Information Studies, the Madison campus where little librarians are made and receive their MLS or MLIS.

## Technology or the Hardware Side

**MUFN** 

Metropolitan Unified Fiber Network. A community area network throughout Dane County using high speed fiber technology to connect public agencies. SCLS and several of its libraries are on the network.

TEACH

Technology for Educational Achievement in Wisconsin is a state agency that administers technology grants, loans and discounts to public libraries and schools. SCLS uses them for networking discounts.

WiscNet

A not-for-profit organization that connects many Wisconsin libraries to the Internet.
