Proposed Fordem Avenue Resurfacing Project - 2016

Project Details - Proposed Work

Street Resurfacing: The proposed project includes removal and replacement of the asphalt pavement with spot repairs of curb and gutter, sidewalk and drive aprons as needed. Curb and gutter will be saved where possible. New concrete sidewalk will be constructed along the west side of Fordem Avenue between McGuire Street and Sherman Avenue where there currently is none. The street widths are proposed to remain the same as existing.

Sanitary Sewer: The City will replace existing sanitary mains (installed in 1954) and in most cases replace laterals from the main to the property line. In limited cases: where the existing lateral is cast iron, appears to be in good condition upon inspection, and runs under a tree the lateral will only be replaced to the back of curb. In those cases, the property owner will not be assessed for the additional footage of replacement that is not completed. If you would like a full lateral replacement to the property line in cases such as this please contact the Sanitary Sewer Contact listed at right. (laterals assessable)

Water Main: The City will replace the existing water main (installed in 1954 & 1968) and reconnect all services to the new main.

Storm Sewer: Replace and upsize storm sewer as necessary, reconnect private storm sewer connections per City standards. (private reconnects assessable)

Trees: City Forestry staff has reviewed the street trees within the project limits and has identified the following trees that are either damaged or in declining condition to be removed:

- 18" Locust at 2211 Fordem Avenue
- 22" Maple at 2211 Fordem Avenue
- 12" Maple at 2211 Fordem Avenue

If during the course of construction it is determined that any other trees need to be removed, the adjacent property owners will be notified in accordance with City policy prior to removal. All of the trees within the project limits will be pruned by City Forestry prior to the start of construction. Replanting of trees typically takes place in the spring following completion of the project.

Construction Schedule & Impacts

Tentative Schedule: May 31, 2016 through the October 7, 2016.


Traffic Impacts: Fordem Avenue will remain open to traffic during construction. Access will be maintained for emergency and local traffic. Pedestrian access will be maintained on at least one side of each of the streets at all times, and access to businesses will be maintained as necessary.

Water Shut-offs: An average of two water shut-offs are expected for each property within the project limits, and the timing of these shut-offs will be coordinated as much as possible. A minimum of 48 hours of notice will be provided prior to the shut-offs. Each shut-off may last up to eight hours, but typically last about four hours.

At the start of construction, the existing main will remain in service until the new main is installed and connected to; emergency shut-offs may occur if the old, brittle main is damaged during construction.

Refuse Collection: It will be the contractor's responsibility to allow for refuse collection during construction. Please mark your address on your cart to make sure it is returned if moved. Please contact private collection companies to inform them of the project.
