Madison General Ordinance Sec. 33.09(1) (2/2014 - formerly 33.26) - Establish and maintain liaison between the Common Council and the County Board for the purpose of

- 1. conferring on matters of mutual interest and
- 2. to provide a means for advising both governing bodies on matters where there may be an apparent conflict or difference in interest between the City and the County.

7.20 OTHER COMMITTEES OF THE COUNTY BOARD.

(intro.) The following are constituted as continuing committees of the county board: (2) City-County Liaison Committee. County members of this committee shall be four (4) in number: three supervisor members appointed by the county board chairperson; and the county executive.

The county executive may appoint one of his or her executive assistants to serve as a designee on the committee with full voting rights.

The committee shall concern itself with matters of mutual interest to the City of Madison and the County of Dane. (6) Land Conservation Committee.
