

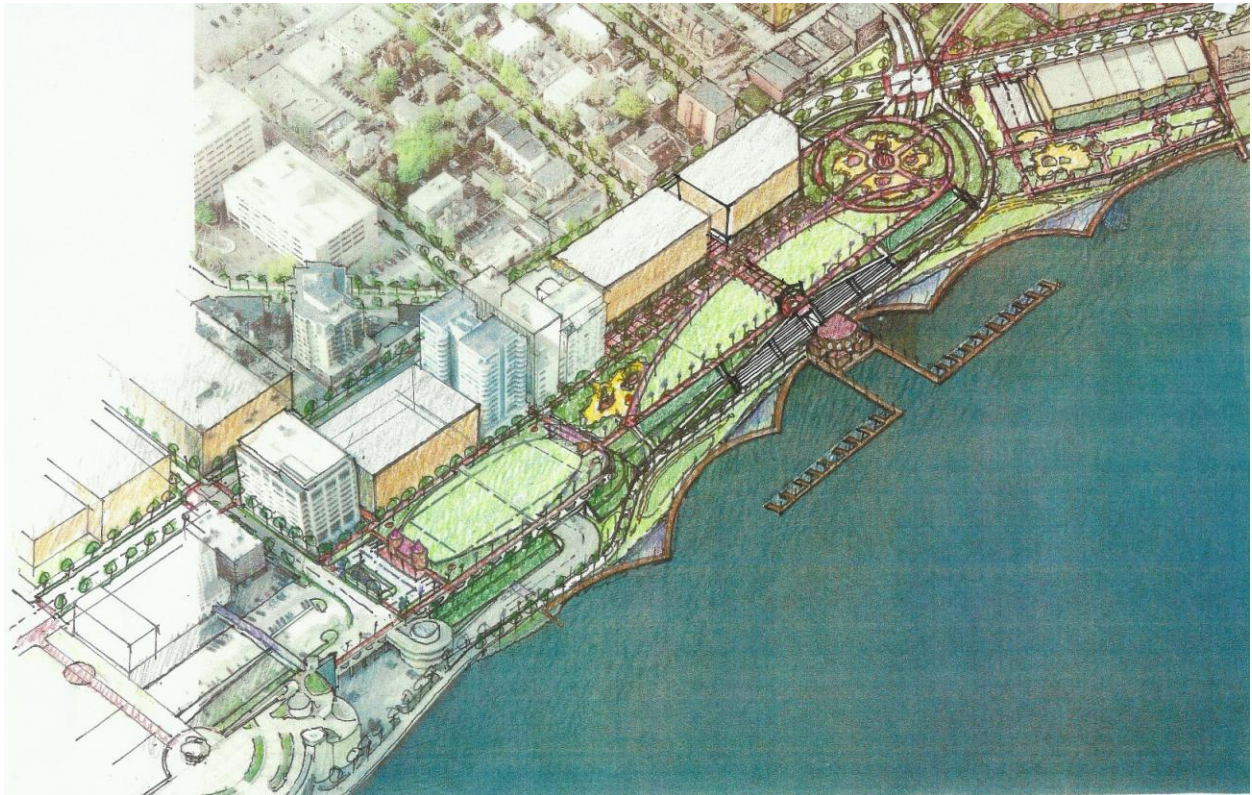

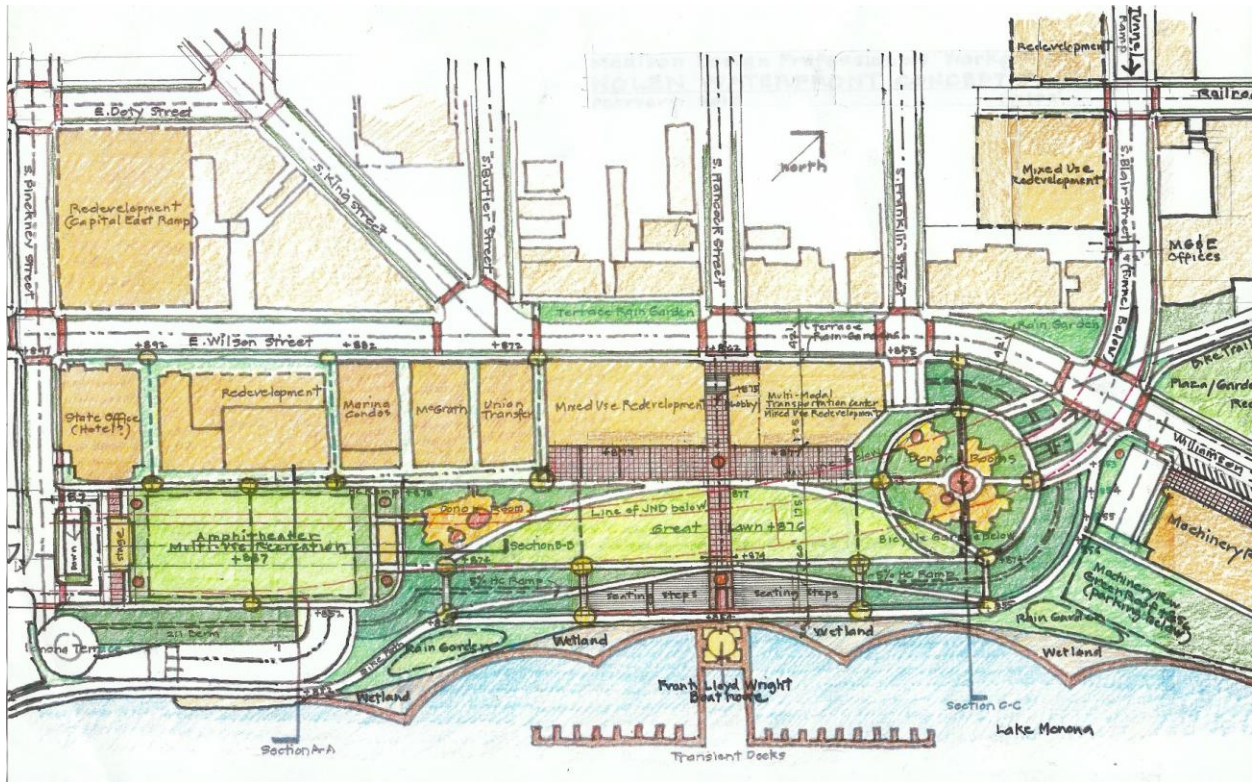

The Nolen Waterfront is a transformative vision for connecting Downtown Madison to Lake Monona that implements John Nolen's 1909 vision for a Great Esplanade along Lake Monona. Key design features of the Nolen Waterfront vision include:

- Raised deck over John Nolen Drive
- 9 AC lakefront park
- 500 car parking ramp
- Connections to Monona Terrace and State Capitol
- Multiple pedestrian and bicycle connections
- Frank Lloyd Wright Boathouse and transient docking
- Multi-modal transportation center
- USH 151 underpass improves Blair Street intersection
- Sustainable design
- Catalytic redevelopment
