I am writing to you in regards to the liquor license application we filed with your office for SSP America, Inc. Per my phone call with your office this morning, I have notified the Alderperson, Alcohol Policy Coordinator and the Police Captain of our pending application.

As you may be aware, the Dane County Regional Airport is currently undergoing significant renovations and it will likely impact the proposed premises. There are three additional restaurants (points of sale) that we intended on adding to our license after it was issued. However, I was just advised that two of these restaurants are now scheduled to open a lot sooner than I originally anticipated. Mad Town Gastro Pub and Metcalfe's are scheduled to open on August 15th and Vintage Wine & Tapas Bar is scheduled to open on November 15th. In coordination with these openings, the temporary bars (noted on the application as Stella Bar and Goose Island Bar will be closing).

I wanted to confirm with you that the way to handle this would be to file a Change of Licensed Premises application once our currently pending application is approved. Is a public hearing required for a Change of Licensed Premises application? If so, can I file a Change of Licensed Premises application on June 20th (while our other application is technically still pending) in order to have the additional locations added by August 2nd? We would just wait to have everything done on the August 2nd meeting, but we need Stella Bar and Goose Island Bar licensed as soon as possible as they are currently not covered under the existing licenses and the Airport wants these temporary bars set up to accommodate passengers while the other restaurants are under construction.

Upon your review of the foregoing, please advise how you wish for us to proceed in order to remain in compliance. Thank you for your kind assistance with this matter.
