

# STREET EVENT CLEANUP AND RECYCLING PLAN

- Include plans for collection and disposal of materials during and after event number and location of garbage/recycling containers and dumpsters; number/schedule of volunteers/staff assigned to collection and cleanup.

## Provide Detailed Trash/Recycling/Cleanup Plans:

- Contracted with Advanced Disposal, 300 Raemisch Road, Waunakee, WI 53597, and are working with Alan Winer.
- Advanced Disposal is HDM's current garbage/recycling contractor.
- HDM currently has (1) 8 yard garbage container and (1) 8 yard recycle container. We have contracted for (1) 30 yard garbage container and (1) 30 yard recycle container.
- The 8 yard and 30 yard containers will be placed on the East side of the HDM building. Advanced Disposal will empty the containers Friday and again on Monday. They do not provide pickup service on the weekends.
- We will have 25 festival boxes (cardboard with plastic liners) for recycling and 25 garbage barrels. They will be
  placed at each parking site, at the entrance/exit of THTH, and at 4 sites at HDM (near the porta-pots, near the
  food/beverage area, in the east grassy area and the north grassy area.
- There will be volunteers stationed by the HDM event site garbage areas and periodic scheduled emptying will be
  done. We are working with local boy and girl scout units. We will have 2 adults per shift overseeing the garbage
  and cleanup.
- Each parking area and both event sites will be cleaned at scheduled periodic times throughout the day and a final pick up each morning at 8am.
- Advanced Disposal professionals will determine the best placement of our garbage and recycling containers on the HDM site.

## Introduction

The Operation Badger Base Planning Committee is offering the following suggestions as a traffic plan for the event. Motorist safety on converging highways and event visitors is our primary concern. The intersection of Highway 12 & 18 and Millpond Road is pictured in Figure 1. This is the single access point to our event site which is located in the 6200 block of Millpond Road.



#### **Event Site Overview**

The following businesses are located within the Millpond Road area and their available parking spaces are noted;

- Yahara Hills Golf Course 340 parking
- BP Gas Station 10 Parking
- Reverend Jim's Restaurant 90 parking
- Norandex Building Supply 25 parking
- Magnuson Hotel 110 parking
- Apartment Complex on Evan Acres Road 48 parking

- Harley-Davidson of Madison Dealership 100 parking Our Event Site Sponsor
- Ho-Chunk Gaming, Madison 830 Parking Major Sponsor Of The Event
- Existing Business Parking Spaces Available 1,560

**OBB will be adding 1,240 parking spaces** on lots adjoining the event site. Some of the spaces will be on paved ground and others on mowed grass sites. The **total available spaces** within the Millpond Road area will be **2,800.** There are a **possible 200 additional spaces** if the City of Madison approves our request for on street parking on Millpond Road and Evan Acres Road (Black areas on the map). We encourage you sharing your experience regarding the number of recommended parking spaces for an event of this size. We plan on having volunteer parking attendants at all event lots and will provide an exit detour map hand-out for all motorists.

## **Traffic Plan Suggestions**

There are three main factors involved with creating a safe traffic plan for event access;

- 1. Provide ample parking spaces for all vehicles that enter the Millpond Road area.
- 2. Adjust traffic flow on 12 & 18 so that highway backups are reduced or eliminated.
- 3. Allow free-flow exit from the Millpond Road intersection to detours.

The suggested changes to this intersection are outline below;

- Access into the event site will be from east bound 12 & 18 only.
- Traffic lanes on east bound 12 & 18 will be divided into a through-traffic left lane and event-traffic right turn only lane into Millpond Road.
- The normal right lane through traffic lane would be closed before the Millpond intersection as the traffic is divided between through-traffic and event traffic.
- This closure will effectively turn the right lane into a merge lane past the Millpond intersection for vehicles exiting east bound on 12 & 18. This would create a free-flow of traffic exiting the event area.
- No left turns would be allowed onto 12 &18 from Millpond west bound or into Millpond from west bound 12 & 18.
- Exiting the event area will be restricted to right turns only from Millpond with directions to follow detours for Madison return or Interstate 90/94 access.

The 12 & 18/Millpond intersection is shown below under normal traffic conditions. Left turns from Millpond onto 12 & 18 westbound require a full stop and, as east bound traffic clears, make a left turn. Eliminating left turns onto 12 & 18 or into Millpond would significantly reduce traffic wait times and hazards.






The following maps indicate the lane closure (Orange), through traffic lane (Yellow), event right turn lane (Green), and right turn exit lane (Blue).
