
The route begins with a start at the top of King Street on the Capitol Square. Participants will be marshaled according to pace (fast runners, slower runners, fast walkers, slower walkers). Participants will head down King Street to Wilson then across Blair/Williamson/John Nolen to the Bike Path. Participants will follow the bike path along Lake Monona out to Olin Park. They will then do a short out and back on Olin Turville Count before following the Wingra Creek underpass beneath John Nolen to Goodman Pool.

Overview of Race Management Plan:

Safety and Security Plan:

- Participants will line up in the designated staging area (Top of King Street back to MLK)
- Course Marshals will be stationed at key intersections directing runners/walkers (King/E. Main).

Turn-by-turn:

- Start on the Capital Square, on East Main at corner of Pickney.
- Heading down King St. veer left on E. Wilson.
- Cross through intersection at John Nolen as if heading towards Williamson St., take immediate right onto Lake Short Path heading south.
- Exit Lake Short Path Lakeside St, crossing the road and continuing on the left side of the road to maintain access to/from boat ramp.
- After passing access to boat ramp, route shifts to the right side of the road as they continue through the park gate.
- A short distance, the route turns 180 degrees prior to the next park gate, and heads to the Wingra Creek underpass.
- Continuing the Wingra Creek underpass, under John Nolen Dr. and Olin Ave.
- Along the bike path towards the Maintenance Building at Goodman Park
- Through a portion of the Maintenance Building Parking Lot and towards the back entrance of Goodman Pool
- Finish Line along the path near grass area behind the pool
