The group met on June 22 to continue its work on a brochure to provide guidance to residents about planting in yards and terraces that will also be available on the city's website and can be shared through neighborhood list serves and newsletters. Also discussed was a "transition memo" describing the work group to be shared with the incoming Food Policy Director. City staff involved with the Edible Landscapes application process will be invited to the next meeting to review the permit process and clarify staff's role; an FAQ document is being developed, and additional outreach strategies will be discussed to inform the community about this program.
