Hi Aaron and Netalee,

I apologize for missing the June 15 ALRC meeting and the meeting you attended with the MNA preservation and development committee to discuss your application for a class B beer class C wine license. I want you to know I support your application but I need clarification about conditions discussed at the MNA P&D committee meeting. It was conveyed to me that you stated you would voluntarily agreed to stop serving alcohol at 11p. Is the information I have accurate?

Through a misstep, MNA did not send a letter to the ALRC requesting the 11p condition, so the Commission did not have the opportunity to hear your opinion or ask if you would voluntarily agree. They granted your license until 2a as allowed by state law. As you may know, the ALRC or the Council can't put conditions on your license without your consent.

If you are willing to add the 11 p condition, I will make a motion to amend the resolution from the floor to add the condition to the license but I need formal written or verbal acknowledgement from you that you accept.

It would be great if you sent me a reply to this email stating your willingness to accept the condition that you would stop serving alcohol at 11p. If you can attend the Common Council meeting Tuesday to register and testify that you will support a condition be placed on your hours of alcohol service that would be even better.

The Council meeting is in room 201 of the City County Building starting at 6:30p. Your license application is #7 on the agenda so it should come up immediately after the 6:45 public hearings begin.
