Dear Mr. Strub:

Your Certified Survey Map ("CSM") for the consolidation of property generally located at 614 Vera Ct., including Lots 24-31 of the First Addition Colony Park Apartment Plat, all being a part of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 26, Township 8 North, Range 9 East, City of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin, is hereby **conditionally approved**. The property is zoned Suburban Residential-Varied 1 (SR-V1). The conditions of approval from the reviewing agencies to be satisfied prior to final approval and recording of the CSM are:

- 1. Revise the CSM to meet the requirements pursuant to Section 16.23(7)(a), MGO, including the following:
 - a. Providing a date on the map; and
 - b. Provide the location and names of adjacent subdivisions, including those areas currently designated at "Lands".

Please contact Brenda Stanley of the City Engineering Division at 261-9127 if you have questions regarding the following four (4) items:

- 1. All outstanding Madison Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD) charges are due and payable prior to Engineering sign-off, unless otherwise collected with a Developer's/Subdivision Contract. Contact Mark Moder (608-261-9250) to obtain the final MMSD billing a minimum of two (2) working days prior to requesting City Engineering sign-off (Section 16.23(9)(d)(4), MGO).
- 2. A minimum of two (2) working days prior to requesting City Engineering sign-off on the CSM the Applicant shall contact either Tim Troester at 261-1995 (ttroester@cityofmadison.com) or Brenda Stanley at 608-261-9127 (bstanley@cityofmadison.com) to obtain the final stormwater utility charges that are due and payable prior to consolidation of the properties. The stormwater utility

charges (as all utility charges) are due for the previous months of service. All charges shall be cleared prior to the consolidation (and subsequent obsolesces of the existing parcel) (POLICY).

- 3. Arrows shall be added to the certified survey map indicating the direction of drainage for each property line not fronting on a public street. In addition, the certified survey map shall include lot corner elevations, for all lot corners, to the nearest 0.25-foot. The following notes shall be added to the certified survey map pursuant to Section 16.23 (9)(D), MGO:
 - a. Arrows indicate the direction of surface drainage swale at individual property lines. Said drainage swale shall be graded with the construction of each principal structure and maintained by the lot owner unless modified with the approval of the City Engineer. Elevations given are for property corners at ground level and shall be maintained by the lot owner.
 - b. All lots within this certified survey are subject to public easements for drainage purposes which shall be a minimum of 6-feet in width measured from the property line to the interior of each lot except that the easements shall be 12-feet in width on the perimeter of the certified survey. For purposes of two (2) or more lots combined for a single development site, or where two (2) or more lots have a shared driveway agreement, the public easement for drainage purposes shall be a minimum of six (6) feet in width and shall be measured only from the exterior property lines of the combined lots that create a single development site, or have a shared driveway agreement, except that the easement shall be twelve (12) feet in width along the perimeter of the certified survey. Easements shall not be required on property lines shared with greenways or public streets. No buildings, driveways, or retaining walls shall be placed in any easement for drainage purposes. Fences may be placed in the easement only if they do not impede the anticipated flow of water.

NOTE: IN THE EVENT OF A CITY OF MADISON PLAN COMMISSION AND/OR COMMON COUNCIL APPROVED REDIVISION OF A PREVIOUSLY SUBDIVIDED PROPERTY, THE UNDERLYING PUBLIC EASEMENTS FOR DRAINAGE PURPOSES ARE RELEASED AND REPLACED BY THOSE REQUIRED AND CREATED BY THE CURRENT APPROVED SUBDIVISION.

Information to Surveyor's: In addition to notes such as this, WI State Plat Review now enforces the requirement that easements or other reference lines/areas be graphically shown, dimensioned and tied when they represent fixed locations. They will accept a "typical detail" when the easement or restriction can be effectively described and retraced from the typical detail (Sections 16.23(3)(a)(2)(c) (plats) and 16.23 (5)(g)(1) (CSM), MGO).

4. The following note shall be added to the certified survey map: "All lots created by this certified survey map are individually responsible for compliance with Chapter 37 of the Madison General Ordinances in regard to storm water management at the time they develop."

Please contact Jeff Quamme of the Mapping Section of the City Engineering Division at 266-4097 if you have questions regarding the following eight (8) items.

1. There is a portion of a public utility easement that is intended to be released. The City's rights shall be released by separate document prepared by City Office of Real Estate Services. Applicant must prepare metes and bounds legal descriptions and scale map exhibits for the portions to be released

and provide to Engineering Land Records Coordinator Jeff Quamme for review (608-266-4097) (jrquamme@cityofmadison.com). Upon approval of the exhibits and payment of the required \$500 administration fee (check payable to City of Madison Treasurer) to cover staff time and recording costs, Engineering will create the necessary Office of Real Estate Services (ORES) Project. ORES staff will then administer the release document(s) and record with the Dane County Register of Deeds. If any release is required to be completed prior to recording of the CSM, acknowledgement of the release and document number shall be noted on the face of the plat. Also provide the recorded copies of the releases by the other utilities serving this development.

- 2. Wisconsin Administrative Code A-E 7.08 identifies when Public Land System (PLS) tie sheets must be filed with the Dane County Surveyor's office. The Developer's Surveyor and/or Applicant must submit copies of required tie sheets or monument condition reports for all monuments, including center of sections of record, used in this survey, to Jeff Quamme, City Engineering (jrquamme@cityofmadison.com). If a new tie sheet is not required under Wis. Stat. A-E 7.08, Engineering requests a copy of the latest tie sheet on record with Dane County Surveyor's office and shall be attached to a signed and sealed monument condition report. The Applicant shall identify monument types on all PLS corners included on the Plat or CSM. Note: Land tie to two PLS corners required.
- 3. The Applicant shall submit to Jeff Quamme, prior to Engineering sign-off of the subject plat, one (1) digital CADD drawing and one (1) signed copy of the CSM to the Mapping/GIS Section of the Engineering Division either as hard copy or Adobe pdf file format. The digital CADD file shall be submitted in the WISDOT County Coordinate System, Dane County Zone datum in either Auto CAD Version compatible with MicroStation Version V8i, MicroStation Version V8i or older or Universal DXF Formats. The digital CADD file(s) shall contain the minimum of the items stated below, each on a separate layer name/level number. All line work shall be void of gaps and overlaps that would cause any parcel, street or easement to not properly close. All line work orientation and geometrics shall match the dimensioning as labeled on the final recorded plat:
 - a. Right-of-Way lines (public and private)
 - b. Lot lines
 - c. Lot numbers
 - d. Lot/Plat dimensions
 - e. Street names
 - f. Easement lines (i.e. street, sanitary, storm (including wetland & floodplain boundaries) water, pedestrian/bike/walkway, or any public and/or private interest easement except local service for Cable TV, gas, electric and fiber optics).

NOTE: This Transmittal is a separate requirement from the required Engineering Streets Section for design purposes. The Developer/Surveyor shall submit new updated final plat, electronic data and a written notification to Engineering Mapping for any changes to the plat which occur subsequent to any original submittal of data and prior to final sign-off.

4. Prior to Engineering final sign-off for Plats or Certified Survey Maps (CSM), the final Plat or CSM must be submitted to Engineering Division Surveyor/Land Records Coordinator for final technical review and approval. This submittal must occur a minimum of two (2) working days prior to final Engineering Division sign-off. Electronic mail submittal of the FINAL Plat or CSM in PDF file format is preferred. Transmit to irquamme@cityofmadison.com.

- 5. The Applicant shall revise the CSM to include a label for Petterle Place on the map and the existing buildings on the map.
- 6. The Applicant shall revise the CSM to show the City of Madison 1991 record coordinates for the two section corners tied into this CSM.
- 7. The Applicant shall revise the direction of the first 50' radius curve in the legal description on line 5. The arc direction is Northeasterly, Northerly and Westerly.
- 8. The Applicant shall provide a consent of Mortgagee per the title work and as required by the City of Madison.

- 1. All operating private wells shall be identified and permitted by the Water Utility in accordance with Section 13.21, MGO.
 - All unused private wells shall be abandoned in accordance with Section 13.21, MGO.

Please contact Jennifer Frese of the Office of Real Estate Services at 267-8719 if you have any questions regarding the following eight (8) items:

- 1. OWNER'S CERTIFICATION: Signature block certifications shall be executed by all parties of interest, pursuant to Wis. Stats. 236.21(2)(a). All signatory parties shall provide documentation that proves said signatories have legal authority to sign the Owner's Certificate. The title of each certificate shall be consistent with the ownership interest reported in the most recent title report. The executed original hard stock recordable CSM shall be presented at the time of sign-off.
- 2. MORTGAGEE/VENDOR CERTIFICATION: Include a certificate of consent for all mortgagees/vendors and executed prior to CSM approval sign-off.
- 3. CERTIFICATE AND CONSENT REQUIREMENTS:
 - a. All ownership consents and certifications for the subject lands shall conform to Wis. Stats. 236.21(2) and 236.29 by including the language ...surveyed, divided, mapped and <u>dedicated</u>....
 - b. A Consent of Lessee shall be included for all tenant interests in excess of one year, recorded or unrecorded, and executed prior to CSM sign-off.
 - c. Include the Register of Deeds name in the certificate.
 - d. <u>City of Madison Plan Commission Certificate:</u> Pursuant to Section 16.23(5)(e)(4), MGO, and Wis. Stats. 236.21(2) (a), all CSMs that are subject to the review and approval of the City of Madison shall contain the following certificate of approval:

- 4. REAL ESTATE TAXES: As of July 14, 2016, the 2015 real estate taxes are paid for the subject property.
 - Per Wis. Stats. 236.21(3) and Section 16.23(5)(g)(1), MGO, the property owner shall pay all real estate taxes that are accrued or delinquent for the subject property prior to CSM recording. This includes property tax bills for the prior year that are distributed at the beginning of the year. Receipts from the City of Madison Treasurer are to be provided before or at the time of sign-off.
- SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS: As of <u>July 14, 2016</u>, there is a special assessment reported for one of the parcels within the CSM boundary. All known special assessments are due and payable prior to CSM approval sign-off. If special assessments are levied against the property in the interim, they shall be paid in full pursuant to Ordinance Enactment No. ORD-08-00094, ID No. 10847, Enactment Date 8/23/2008.
- STORM WATER FEES: Please coordinate with Tim Troester (608-267-1995) or Brenda Stanley (608-261-9127) in the City Engineering Division to obtain any outstanding storm water management fees from the City of Madison Water Utility. Receipts for the payment of the prorated fee shall be presented prior to CSM approval sign-off.
- 7. TITLE REPORT UPDATE: Pursuant to Section 16.23(5)(g)(4), MGO, the Owner shall furnish an updated title report to Jenny Frese in City's Office of Real Estate Services (ifrese@cityofmadison.com), as well as the survey firm preparing the proposed CSM. The report shall search the period subsequent to the date of the initial title report (7-7-16) submitted with the CSM application and include all associated documents that have been recorded since the initial title report. Surveyor shall update the CSM with the most recent information reported in the title update.
- 8. CSM REVISION REQUIREMENTS:
 - a. Include Notes on the CSM that describe and identify by document number all existing non-traceable restrictions or agreements cited in record title.
 - b. Depict and dimension all existing improvements (buildings, drives, parking lots, etc.), encroachments, wells, and septic systems located within the CSM boundary.
 - c. Coordinate with City staff for the partial release of the 5' public utility easement per the 1st Addition to Colony Park Apartment Plat.

Specific questions regarding the comments or conditions contained in this letter should be directed to the commenting agency.

A resolution approving the CSM and authorizing the City to sign it and any other documents related to the proposed land division will be before the Common Council on August 2, 2016.

As soon as the comments and conditions have been satisfied as verified with a completed affidavit form (attached), the original along with the revised Certified Survey Map, with all signatures and approvals from the reviewing agencies, shall be brought to this office for final sign-off. You or your client may then record the Certified Survey Map at the Dane County Register of Deeds. For information on recording procedures and fees, contact the Register of Deeds at 266-4141.

Prior to City Engineering Main Office final sign-off of the CSM, the final CSM shall be submitted to the Engineering Division Surveyor/Land Records Coordinator for final technical review and approval. This submittal must occur a minimum of two (2) working days prior to final Engineering Division sign-off. E-mail submittal of the final CSM in PDF file format is preferred. Transmit to irquamme@cityofmadison.com.

The Owner shall furnish to the Office of Real Estate Services and the survey firm preparing the CSM an updated title report covering the period between the date of the initial title report and the date when final sign-off is requested. The surveyor shall update the CSM with the most recent information reported in the title update.

Upon acceptance and recording of the Certified Survey Map by the Dane County Register of Deeds, please transfer the recorded volume, document number, and page numbers to the copies and forward a copy to this office for our records. The original survey map with the recording information is permanently kept on file in the Dane County Register of Deeds Office. A copy of the recorded document can be obtained from the Register of Deeds Office, Room 110, City-County Building or the Real Estate Office in the Madison Department of Planning and Development.

Any appeal from this action, including the conditions of approval, must be filed with the Circuit Court within 30 days from the date of this letter. The approval of this CSM shall be null and void if not recorded in twelve (12) months from the date of the approving resolution or this letter, whichever is later.
