A motion was made by Rummel, seconded by Hill, to recommend to the Plan Commission that the Commission finds that the building at 219 West Gilman has historic value based on its status as a contributing structure in a National Register historic district; to recommend to the Plan Commission that the Commission finds that the building at 940 East Dayton Street has historic value related to the vernacular context of Madison's built environment, but the building itself is not historically, architecturally or culturally significant; and to recommend to the Plan Commission that the Commission finds that the buildings at 2901 Dryden Drive, 910 Ann Street and 2605 Todd Drive have no known historic value.
