# **REPORT TO THE MONONA TERRACE BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

# September 15, 2016

#### A. <u>Operations:</u>

- The Command Center is now fully renovated.
- The camera expansion project is in progress and cables are being installed now.
- Strategic Planning is in progress for implementation in 2017.
- Maintenance has cleaned the exterior of the Monona Terrace parking ramp structure using pressure washers and water only. Assistance from other city departments will be required to clean the section of ramp that stretches over John Nolen Drive.
- An arborist inspected the facility's trees and will draft a plan for treatment to sustain healthy plant life.
- The Common Council approved the resolution to replace the Fire Alarm Panel and that project will begin soon.

#### B. <u>Community Relations:</u>

- Dane Dances! Highlights:
  - Total attendance reached 13,652 over the course of four concerts
  - Average attendance reached 3,413
- PechaKucha Night Madison August 24
  - Presented by High Tech Happy Hour (HTHH)
  - Attendance = 90
- Staff organized a team from Monona Terrace to volunteer during the United Way "Days of Caring" events. Twelve employees from different departments volunteered for four agencies: 100 Black Men of Madison, Porchlight, West Madison Senior Center, and ARC.

- Staff has begun putting together a community organizing team to work on Madison Maker Faire for May 13, 2017. The group will recruit makers in a variety of areas including eco-design, engineering, e-textiles, and K-12/youth organizations.
- Staff marketed Madison Mini Maker Faire 2017 at Forward Fest neXXpo held here at Monona Terrace. This event is a gathering of innovative people and businesses in the Greater Madison area.
- Isthmus Publishing has signed on as a media sponsor for Concerts on the Rooftop 2017.
- Zendesk has signed on as a presenting sponsor for Maker Faire 2017.
- The Community Relations team welcomes two interns for the 2016-17 school year, both seniors at UW Whitewater: Sarell Martin and Lindsey Tutaj.

## C. <u>Gift Shop:</u>

- New Frank Lloyd Wright designed sandstone coaster sets and trivets are in stock.
- The local gifts product line has a new addition, candy from a local candy maker. Proceeds from the company go to support college scholarships for recent high school graduates in the Madison area.
- Staff is working with the Frank Lloyd Wright Foundation for next year's 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Frank Lloyd Wright.
- Web sales are steady. There will be updates to the site over the next couple of months.

## D. Sales and Marketing:

- The August booking pace report is attached.
- Monona Terrace was represented by the sales team at the following networking functions and other events: SMBA Networking, In Business Intros, Brava Lunch Series, MAGNET Networking, Ultimate Chamber Mixer and the GM/DOS Meeting.
- Staff participated in the United Way "Days of Caring" by helping stuff back packs for the 100 Black Men of Wisconsin service organization.
- To improve the look of our temporary interior signage used to provide information and guide attendees traffic flow, we have purchased black frames to hold the signs when they are placed on easels throughout the building.

- First Business has chosen Monona Terrace for their annual meeting series in 2017; it will be their tenth year here. Returning as well is the **Waisman Center** for their Spring Fashion Show for All Abilities. They have been meeting at MT since 2009.
