DRAFTER'S ANALYSIS: This ordinance allows colleges and universities and schools, arts, technical or trade as a permitted use in the SEC District. This ordinance also specifically provides a new supplemental regulation requiring that the City Traffic Engineer must approve a Traffic Demand Management Plan for any such use.

The Common Council of the City of Madison do hereby ordain as follows:

1. Table 28F-1 of Subsection (1) of Section 28.082 entitled "Employment District Uses" of the Madison General Ordinances is amended by amending therein the following:

2. Section 28.151 entitled "Colleges and Universities" of the Madison General Ordinances is amended by creating therein the following:

"Colleges and Universities. For uses established in employment districts, the applicant shall submit a Traffic Demand Management plan to be approved by the Traffic Engineer and to be kept on file with the Zoning Administrator."

- 3. Section 28.151 entitled "School, Arts, Technical or Trade" of the Madison General Ordinances is amended by creating therein the following:
- "(d) For uses established in employment districts, the applicant shall submit a Traffic Demand Management plan to be approved by the Traffic Engineer and to be kept on file with the Zoning Administrator."
