The City of Madison is proposing reconstruct the above referenced street in 2017. This project will involve special assessments to the owners of property adjacent to the project. The property owners will be assessed for various items included with this proposed project. The final assessment, which will be billed after the completion of the project, is payable in one lump sum or over a period of 8 years, with 3.0% interest charged on the unpaid balance.

Fact and Details Sheet Proposed Woodrow Street Reconstruction — Project 10906

Project Details - Proposed Work

Sanitary Sewer: The City will replace existing mains (installed in 1925 and 1957), and in most cases replace laterals from the main to the property line. In limited cases where the existing lateral is cast iron, appears to be in good condition upon inspection, and runs under a tree, the lateral will only be replaced to the back of curb. In those cases, the owner will not be assessed for the additional footage of replacement that is not completed. If you would like a full lateral replacement to the property line in cases such as this please contact the Sanitary Sewer Contact listed at right. (laterals assessable).

The existing sanitary sewer is currently routed toward Terry Place, though the side yard between 852 and 856 Woodrow Street, which presents maintenance and operational difficulties. During the project, the sanitary sewer will be re-routed to connect into an existing sanitary manhole south of Edgewood Drive.

Water Main: Replace the existing water mains (installed in 1919, 1938), and reconnect services to the new main.

Storm Sewer: Replace and extend storm sewer installed in 1950, connect to private storm (typically from sump pumps or downspouts). If you are aware of any existing private storm sewer or private connections (either to the curb or to a structure) from your property please contact Daniel Olivares (private connections assessable).

Rain Gardens: Rain gardens may be installed at the request of property owners, if terrace is deemed by the City to be suitable for rain gardens. The following addresses may have suitable terraces: 820, 826, 830, 840, 866, 878, 890, 2329 Monroe. If you live at any of these addresses and are interested in having a rain garden, please contact Daniel Olivares by 10/1/2016 (assessable). The cost assessed to homeowners for rain gardens is \$100. More info on the terrace rain garden program is available here: http://www.cityofmadison.com/engineering/stormwater/raingardens/terraceraingardens.cfm

Street: Replace the pavement, the existing curb, the driveway aprons, and spot repairs of the existing sidewalk (assessable). Most of the newer curb on the east side of the street, south of Edgewood College Drive will remain. Overall street width will remain the same as exists today.

Because of the required sanitary sewer work, the area south of the Woodrow Street cul-du sac will be disturbed by the sanitary excavation. The existing bike path and turn-around at the west end of Edgewood Drive will be removed and replaced during the project.

Terrace Areas: Existing concrete terrace walkways will be replaced with the project, unless the property owner requests that they are removed. The entire terrace area and public right-of-way will likely be disturbed during the project, so owners should remove any plantings or special landscaping features from the terrace area and right-of-way, prior to the start of construction. Raised planting beds, railings, pavers, and the like, must be removed by the owner prior to the project.

Trees: The majority of the existing trees will remain, but tree removals are planned at the following addresses on Woodrow Street- 830, 840, 878, 938 (2 smaller trees in clearing near bike path), 863/901 (Edgewood College-4 trees), 1000 Edgewood College Drive (Edgewood College-4 trees on Woodrow side of building). Tree removals are generally due to poor condition or are pre-emptive ash removals. The trees within the project limits that remain may be pruned, and/or the roots may be trimmed. Some of the trimming may occur in advance of the project, in Fall 2016. Terrace areas will be evaluated by Forestry for new trees or replacements following the project. For additional information from Forestry, see the back of this sheet.

In order to re-route the sanitary sewer, trees and brush will also need to be removed in an approximate 30' wide zone, extending about 100' south of the existing turn-around at the west end of Edgewood Drive.


Tentative Schedule: April-July 2017

Traffic Impacts: The streets will be closed to through traffic within the project limits. The street will be open to local traffic (residents). Parking will be removed for the project duration. Residential driveways may be closed for up to 2 weeks. Bikes will be detoured off of Edgewood Drive.

Water Shut-offs: An average of two water shut-offs are expected for each property within the project limits. A minimum of 48 hours of notice will be provided prior to the shut-offs. Each shut-off may last up to 8 hours, but typically last about 4 hours. At the start of construction, the existing main will remain in service until the new main is installed and connected to; emergency shut-offs may occur if the old, brittle main is damaged during construction.

Refuse Collection: It will be the contractor's responsibility to allow for refuse collection to continue during construction. Please mark your address on your cart to make sure it is returned if moved.

Supplemental Forestry Info

Tree pruning in advance of the project is required to reduce the risk of damage to the trees during construction. The City of Madison Forestry Section will perform the necessary work. For certain species, especially oak and elm trees, the pruning must be completed by April 1st to reduce the chance of disease. If additional trees need to be removed, City Forestry or City Engineering will notify the adjacent property owner prior to removal.

All ash street trees within the project limits have been or will be evaluated for potential chemical treatment for Emerald Ash Borer (EAB). Ash trees with trunks measuring less than 10" in diameter at 4.5 ft (DBH) from the ground, ash located under high voltage electric distribution lines, and ash that are structurally compromised or in poor condition will not be treated as outlined the City's EAB Plan. Ash trees that do not meet the treatment criteria will be removed prior to construction, and will be removed regardless of the construction project schedule. Including ash removals as part of the project will allow for a faster replacement timeframe. Street trees provide many benefits to our city and are considered an important part of the city's infrastructure. Forestry Section staff will evaluate the terrace for new planting sites and potential replacement sites when the project is complete. There is no additional cost to the adjacent property owner for a tree planting. Street trees are typically planted in the spring of the year following the completion of the construction project. Per Madison General Ordinance 10.10, City Forestry determines tree species and planting locations. Residents cannot choose or plant their own tree in the terrace.
