Thank you for submitting a National Register of Historic Places nomination for the Sylvan Avenue Rodge-Road Historic District in the City of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin.

The nomination packet is considered complete. The nomination will now be reviewed for content and editing; we will be in touch regarding any revisions or additions that are necessary. The nomination materials may be returned if substantial work is needed.

The nomination is now in the queue to be scheduled for review by the Historic Preservation Review Board at one of its quarterly meetings. The Review Board meets in February, May, August and December. Generally, agendas for the board meetings are determined three months prior to the meetings. Currently, due to the high volume of nominations, a nomination may be scheduled for the next meeting or may be deferred to the subsequent meeting. Generally, nominations for tax credit projects are prioritized; however, its place on a future agenda has yet to be determined. When the nomination is being scheduled, you will be contacted to confirm your availability to attend the meeting for your presentation of the nomination to the Review Board.

Madison is a CLG and is allowed time to review the nomination and provide comment. If you haven't done so already, please transit a copy of the nomination to the Commission for their review and send me an email to confirm that it has been sent.
