Applicant's Comments: Demolition of the 1949 USDA Barley and Malt Laboratory. A defunct 9,705 sf USDA research facility, and 800 sf detached garage on 0.72 acres of land. The laboratory has been abandoned since 2006, and our contract calls for complete abatement and demolition of all buildings, utilities, and improvements, returning the land to pristine condition. Upon demolition, the United States will cede the land to the University of Wisconsin, which has no plans for future development.
