WHEREAS, on September 14, 2016, the Transit and Parking Commission held a public hearing regarding proposed Parking Utility rate changes for the lower level of the State Street Capitol Garage and special event parking; and

WHEREAS, the proposed rate at the State Street Capitol Garage – Lower Level is intended to discourage longer-term parking to increase turnover and the availability of short-term parking at this location.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Madison Parking Utility shall establish the following rate structure for parking in the gated section of the State Street Capitol Garage – Lower Level:

\$1.00 per ½ hour for first two hours of parking \$3.00 per ½ hour after two hours of parking Daily maximum of \$30.00

(Evening/Weekend Maximum rates shall not apply to this location).

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the rate is approved with an effective date of December 1, 2016, and that implementation of the new rate structure will occur upon completing installation of equipment and signage, as directed by the City Assistant Parking Utility Manager.

- (a) Cashiered parking rates calculated in half-hour increments; 20-minute grace period
 - The Evening/Weekend Maximum rate applies to cashiered parking during the following time periods:
 - Hours parked after 6 p.m. weeknights (until 5 a.m. the following day); and
 - Hours parked on Saturdays/Sundays (from 5 a.m. until 5 a.m. the following day)

Parking garages can be used free of charge between 9 p.m. and 7 a.m. on days when a snow emergency has been declared.

Coupons: Businesses and individuals can request coupons for distribution to customers/clients.

We invoice for the value of redeemed coupons plus a 10% admin fee.

- (b) All garages and surface lots are enforced 24/7.
- (c) Rate changes for special event parking will be considered separately from this rate schedule in conjunction with potential changes to on-street enforcement hours, as requested at the 2.8.16 TPC Subcommittee Mtg.
- (d) On-street meters are enforced in general from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. UW meters in this area are enforced 8 a.m. to 9 p.m.
- (e) Eligible carpoolers and electric car drivers qualify for the (discounted) Monthly Resident rate and are entitled to immediate occupancy in select facilities.
- (f) Parkers and the Utility are required to provide 30-days notice to terminate monthly parking agreements.
- (g) Regular Monthly Limited Hours, Monday Friday

Premium Permit - 24/7 access, even during events

Night Permit - (Created in 2014) Valid 7 days a week from 6 p.m. to 7 a.m.
