SUMMARY:

The Commission discussed the historic value of the buildings proposed for demolition.

ACTION:

A motion was made by McLean and seconded by Andrzejewski to recommend to the Plan Commission that the Landmarks Commission finds that the building at 3325 E Washington Avenue has no known historic value, and that the building at 501 Walnut has historic value related to the vernacular context of Madison's built environment, but the building itself is not historically, architecturally, or culturally significant. The motion passed by a voice vote.
