To Attorney May:

I am writing this letter to point out two inaccuracies on the document tiled "Final Decision Finding No Jurisdiction and Dismissing the Complaint":

- 1) Katherine Hurtgen's title is misstated in the Final Decision as "Finance Manager at Monona Terrace." Her title is Associate Director, Business and Finance.
- 2) Count 2 the misstates the allegations of Hurtgen's Complaint. Hurtgen's complaint alleged that McManners advised Hurtgen to use a City P-Card to pay a vender to bypass the system and allow payment without an Affirmative Action Plan in place when one was required, and that he did so knowingly.
