Mr. Fugate,

As you are probably aware, construction on the University of Wisconsin Music Hall will begin shortly after the New Year. The limits for this project will be along University Avenue between Lake Street and Park Street. The construction fence for the project will extend past the curb on the north side of University Avenue. This project, in conjunction with the ongoing and pressing safety concerns created by intercity buses stopped and loading in the bus lane on University Avenue, will require the intercity loading location to move. The City of Madison has approved a location on eastbound Langdon Street, before the intersection of Lake Street, across from the Pyle Center (see attached diagram). While no location will be perfect, this spot offers close proximity to the University market. It is also on a street with much slower traffic than University Avenue.

The date of the transition to the new location has been set for Tuesday, January 3, 2017. This coincides with the University of Wisconsin winter break, making the move much easier.
