SPONSOR:				
DRAFTER'S ANALYSIS: Currently, Sec. 28.182(5)(c)4.c.,MGO, requires that a protest petition be filed by noon on the Thursday preceding final Common Council consideration of a zoning map amendment. This ordinance changes that deadline to noon on the Monday before final Common Council consideration. This will allow individuals wishing to protest a zoning map amendment three additional days to compile their petition. With this change, it becomes necessary to also change the deadline for withdrawing a protest petition. This ordinance allows the withdrawal of a protest petition until noon on the day of final Common Council consideration.				
While this ordinance gives petitioners more time to file a petition, it gives staff less time before the Common Council meeting to determine if the petition is valid. Accordingly, this change could result in more referrals if staff is unable to evaluate a petition that is filed the day before the council meeting.

If action on the proposed map amendment is not taken at the initial meeting of the Common Council, additional withdrawals may be again filed with the City Clerk until noon on the Friday beforeday the Common Council again proposes to act upon the map amendment."
