

Assessment Policy

Per the City's standard assessment policy, a portion of the costs to repair alleys is assessed to the adjacent property owners. The City pays 50% of the total costs of the repair work, and the adjacent owners pay the remaining 50% of the costs, and those costs are assessed to each owner based on the linear feet of frontage along the alley. The costs to replace sewer laterals are assessed 25% to the property owner, and the City pays the remaining 75%.

Properties on the eastern half of Conklin Pl will also be assessed a portion of the costs for the new pedestrian lights being installed as part of the Bassett St. reconstruction. Properties on the west half of Conklin Pl were either assessed for pedestrian lights with previous projects or were benefited when lights were installed with development projects. The costs to install pedestrian lighting are assessed 100% to the benefited properties.



Project Details – Proposed Work

Alley Pavement Repairs - The existing pavement on the Conklin-University alley is in very poor condition, so the existing pavement will be removed and replaced with new gravel base and new concrete pavement. The new alley pavement will be installed so that water can drain away from the buildings and down the center of the alley, which will then drain out on Conklin Pl.

Sanitary Sewer - There is an existing sanitary sewer main under this alley. That main will be replaced as part of this project, but, instead or replacing by open trench, the new main will be installed by pipe bursting. This method involves pushing a larger pipe through the existing brittle pipe and then connecting into the manholes at either end of the alley. This method is selected due to the work space and time constraints. Sewer laterals connected to this main will also be replaced.

Coordination with Bassett Reconstruction: N. Bassett St. between Gorham and Dayton (limits shown on map) is also being reconstructed during the same time. The alley work is being bid as part of a contract with the Bassett St. reconstruction. The Bassett St project will involve utility replacement (sanitary sewer, storm sewer, water main) as well as replacement of the curb and pavement and installation of pedestrian scale lighting, and the new pedestrian lighting will benefit properties along Conklin Pl as that is one of the main pedestrian access points for Conklin Pl.

Off street bike lanes, adjacent to the sidewalk, are also being proposed as part of that reconstruction project. These bike lanes would provide for bike access in both directions on these blocks of Bassett St. Work on Bassett St. is expected to take place from the end of May through mid-August 2017. Construction Schedule & Impacts

Tentative Schedule: Work will be completed sometime between late June and the end of July, and the total construction duration will be approximately 3 weeks. The Contractor will provide advanced notice to all properties & businesses prior to starting work.

Traffic/Access Impacts: The alley will be closed to traffic while the sanitary sewer work is being performed, which will take approximately 1 week. The pavement replacement work will be done one half at a time (split north & south), so that there will be access to a portion of the parking and to any dumpsters from at least one end of the alley while that work is taking place. Please note that dumpsters may need to be relocated as necessary depending on which end of the alley is accessible.


Project Details - Proposed Work

Alley Pavement Repairs - The existing alley is constructed of both concrete and asphalt pavements. The portion nearest Johnson St. is concrete pavement, with some asphalt patches, and the rear portion of the alley, near the dumpsters, is an asphalt pavement.

The patched and significantly damaged portions of the concrete pavement will be removed and replaced with new concrete pavement. In locations where cracks may have formed but are not offset or too wide, the cracks will be sealed to prevent water penetration into the pavement. If the pavement is in otherwise sound condition, the crack sealing will be a more cost effective repair to help extend the life of the pavement.

In the asphalt pavement portion of the alley, the existing pavement will be pulverized down to essentially a gravel material, and this will then be regraded, compacted, and a new asphalt pavement will be installed over the top. The new surface will match the existing surface elevation.

Please note that this project only includes pavement repair work on the city-owned portion of the alley. Once a contractor is selected, the City can provide their contact information to any property owners that would like to contact them about possible additional work on private property. However, the City will not include that work as part of the contract and cannot guarantee that the selected contractor will be interested in taking on any additional work.

Fact and Details Sheet Proposed 2017 Bassett Street Reconstruction Project

Project Details - Proposed Work

Sanitary Sewer: Replace & upsize the main (existing mains from 1905 & 1970) to increase capacity and due to poor condition of the existing mains. Replace laterals (*assessable*) to the property line.

Water Main: Replace the existing water mains (dated 1927, 1939 & 1946) and connect all water services to the new main.

Storm Sewer: Replace the storm sewer as necessary to match new curb or to accommodate other utility work. Any private storm sewer connections will be reconnected as necessary to the new storm sewer per City standards (*assessable*)

Street Lights: Install new pedestrian lights where no pedestrian lights exist (*assessable*). The style of the pedestrian lights will match what has previously been installed in the downtown areas.

Street: Replace the asphalt pavement, curb and drive aprons, and replace the sidewalk only as needed (assessable items described in cover letter). Significant changes are proposed for the street; see enclosed plans. A bike lane in either direction (one-way on each side of the street), will be installed adjacent to the sidewalk (6' wide with 1' buffer). The bike lanes will provide for a safer space for bicyclists as well as providing a better connection to the biking network in the City. To fit the new bike lanes, Bassett St. will be narrowed, but will still provide for 2 travel lanes and an increased loading zone area near Gorham; the right turn lane between Johnson and Dayton will be removed.

It is understood that during times with high pedestrian volumes (Kohl Center events), the bike lane adjacent to the sidewalk will effectively function as a shared space between bicyclists and pedestrians.

A new traffic signal will be installed at the intersection of Gorham and Bassett. This signal will provide for a much safer pedestrian and bike crossing at the intersection. The signal will be timed with the existing signals at Broom and Frances St. A detail of the pedestrian & bike crossings is enclosed.

Undergrounding: The City is working with the private utility companies to underground the overhead lines as part of the project. Following the project, some poles may need to remain until the services to each property can be undergrounded. Future mailings will be sent with specifics related to the undergrounding process and any costs or work required for the properties.

Trees: With the proposed changes to the street, all existing terrace trees will be removed. If possible, some trees will be transplanted. Following the project, new street trees will be installed, and this will be done either the fall of 2017 or spring 2018. The new terraces will be wider than existing and further from buildings, so they should provide a better growing environment than existing.

Construction Schedule & Impacts


Tentative Schedule: May 29, 2017 until end of August 2017 (approximately 3 months)

Traffic Impacts: Bassett St. between Gorham St. and Johnson St. will likely be closed during construction. During the closure, local and emergency vehicle access will be provided, and Conklin Pl. would function as a two-way street to Frances St. The project will be reviewed to maintain a lane of traffic between Johnson St. and Dayton St., and the area will also be reviewed for possible temporary loading zone areas. Pedestrian access will be maintained on at least one side of each of the streets at all times, and will be open to all properties where needed. Accommodations will be made during the heavy move-in & move-out days.

Water Shut-offs: An average of two water shut-offs are expected for each property within the project limits. The timing of these shut-offs will be coordinated as much as possible. A minimum of 48 hours of notice will be provided prior to the shut-offs. Each shut-off may last up to 8 hours, but typically last about 4 hours. There may be emergency shut-offs if the old, brittle main is damaged during construction before all properties are connected to the new water main.

Refuse & Mail Collection: Refuse and mail collection will continue as they typically do, and the contractor will be required to provide that access. Please mark your address on your carts before the start of construction in case the contractor moves the cart for collection.
