There are two entertainment licenses before you this evening in District 13. I am writing to share my support for both applications.

52. 46911 Change of Licensed Conditions Sconnie Bar LLC • dba Sconnie Bar • Capacity: 160 1421 Regent St • Agent: Thomas Van Wie Class B Combination Liquor & Beer • 66% alcohol, 33% food, 1% other Aldermanic District 13 (Alder Eskrich) • Police Sector 303 Request to change entertainment from 4 times per month to 4 times per week.

There was significant neighborhood concern when this bar changed ownership, particularly related to noise. I am happy to share that there have been no complaints regarding noise under this new ownership and management. I am supporting this scaled increase in entertainment license capacity, rather than entirely removing conditions, under the expectation this continued respect for neighborhood noise levels will be maintained. We held a neighborhood meeting where residents were understandably nervous about an increase in entertainment, but ultimately seemed to not oppose increase in capacity. However, I do know there are some residents who do not support increased entertainment or bar capacity generally on Regent Street.

This brewery has been a positive addition to the neighborhood and neighbors showed up to support their outdoor seating and indoor entertainment license proposal at our neighborhood meeting. I have also heard from neighbors and residents who are concerned about added outdoor seating and potential for noise from entertainment licenses, but the vast majority of contacts I have received are supportive and positive. I have confidence the owner will continue to be a respectful neighbor and not misuse the privilege of an entertainment license.
