MEMORANDUM

TO: Transportation Ordinance Review Committee

FROM: John W. Strange, Assistant City Attorney

RE: Draft Transportation Ordinances (Legistar File 46249)

At the previous meeting, the Transportation Ordinance Review Committee (TORC) reviewed comments and suggestions from the bodies to which the ordinance was referred. I drafted a Second Substitute Ordinance, which is attached and includes (in highlight) the changes requested by TORC, including:

1. Sec. 33.56(5)(c)7. -- clarifying the role of the Transportation Commission and Board of Public Works in street projects.
2. Sec. 33.55(3) – requiring that the mayor give strong consideration to including members of the BPW and MATP on the TPPB.
3. Sec. 33.55(6)(g) – replacing “entities” with “contracting partners”.
4. Secs. 33.56(5)(a)2. and 33.56(5)(b)1.-2. -- moving the consideration of transit fares and off-street parking rates from the TPPB to the TC and including reference to TC role in making recommendations for on-street parking.
5. Sec. 33.56(3)(a) – changing reference from “frequent user” of bikes and ped to “primary mode” of transportation.

The TORC held off on making decisions related to two additional items that it discussed:

- a) whether to recommend hiring a director of transportation; and
- b) whether the regional representative should sit on the TPPB or TC.
