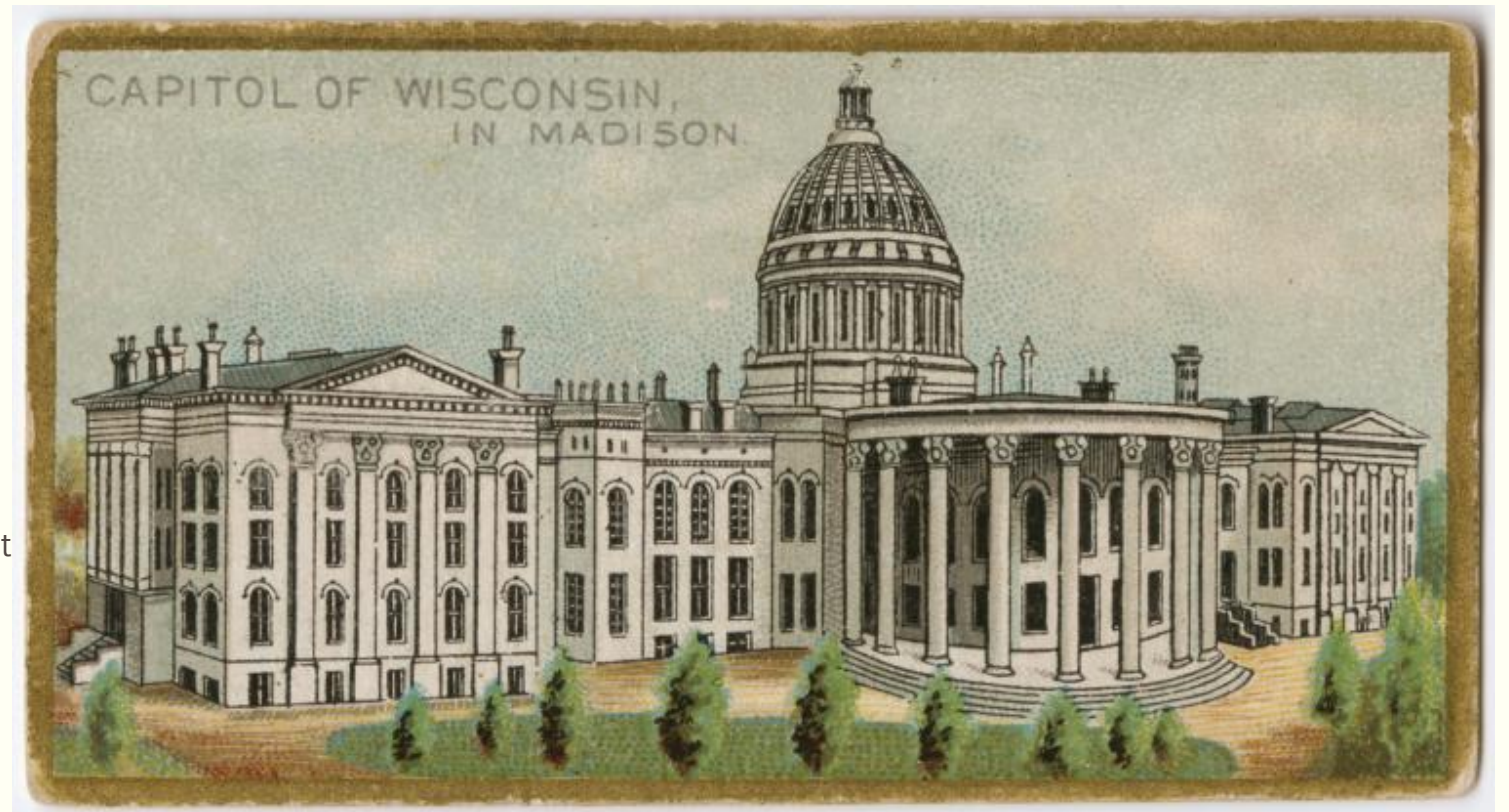

The Executive Committee is made up of the officers of the organization as well as the Past President, and Vice President, and two At-Large members.

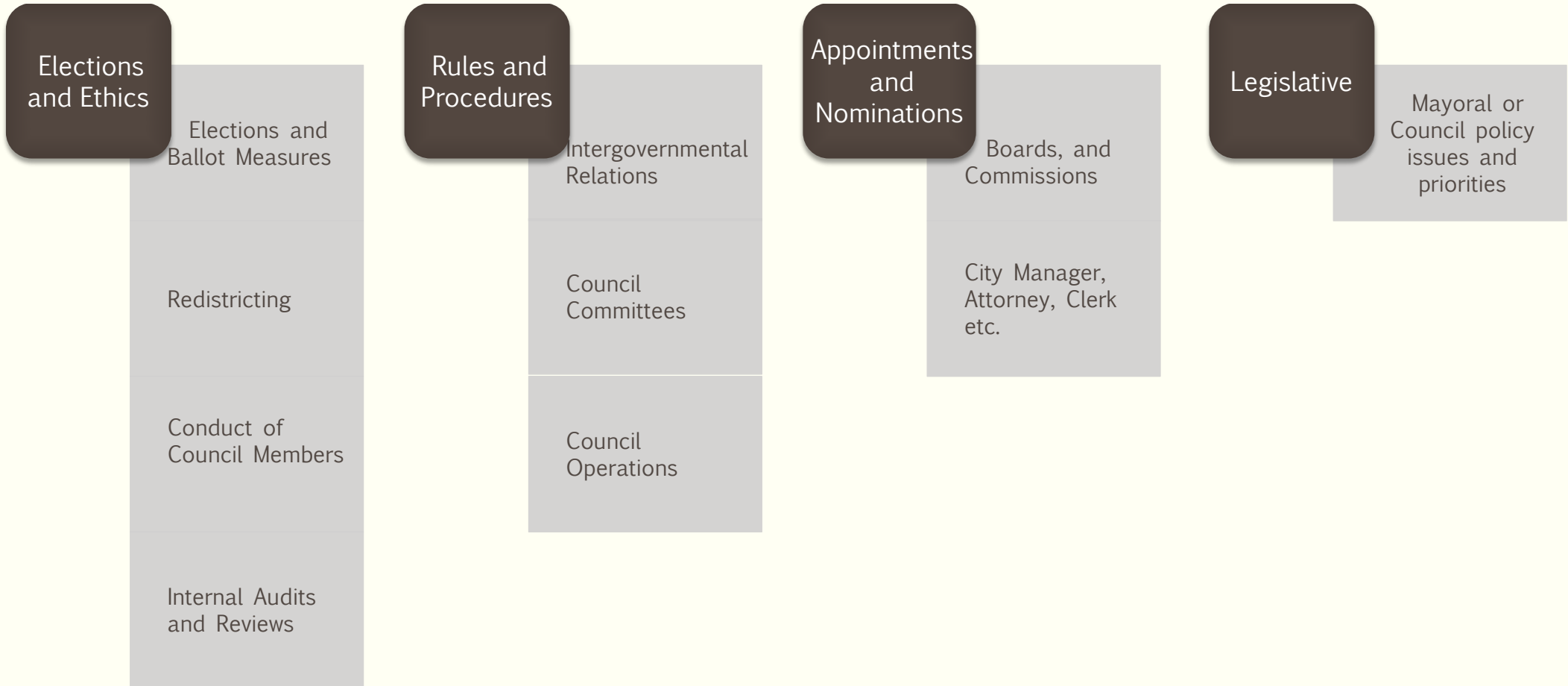

Seattle	Education, Equity, and Governance Committee	Relevant legislative matters including the educational achievement gap
El Paso	Districting Commission	Makes recommendations to the Council concerning adjustments of the boundaries of districts
Tucson	Charter Review Committee	Reviews and make recommendations regarding possible amendments to sections of the City Charter
