To: Property Owners along Cherokee Drive, Chippewa Drive, Hiawatha Drive, and Ottawa Trail Re: Project No. 11571 Proposed Sidewalk Installation Project & Public Hearing

The City of Madison is proposing to install sidewalk on Chippewa Drive from Hiawatha Drive to Cherokee Drive. Enclosed with this letter is a fact sheet with some details on the proposed project along with a notification for the Public Hearing before the Board of Public Works. The date, time and location of the public hearing can be found on the notification.

This project will involve special assessments to the owners of property adjacent to the project. The property owners will be assessed for various items included with this proposed project. The costs of some items are shared between the property owner and the City, while other costs are assessed entirely to the property owner. A table detailing the City's standard assessment policy for these items is included in the fact sheet.

Also enclosed is a Schedule of Assessments, which shows the property owner's share of the estimated costs that will be assessed to each property adjacent to the project. After the work is complete, a final assessment will be calculated based on bid prices and work actually performed. The final assessment, which will be billed after the completion of the project, is payable in one lump sum or over a period of eight years, with 3.0% interest charged on the unpaid balance.

Note that the standard assessment policy for this type of project indicates that the costs of new sidewalk are to be assessed entirely to the adjacent property owners. A "Safe Routes" grant is currently included as part of the adopted 2017 City budget. The amount due for the sidewalk installation will be reduced by half upon approval of the proposed sidewalk installation and approval of the grant funds. The enclosed estimated assessments for each property include the entire costs for the sidewalk installation; if approved, the grant would be applied to the amount due with the final assessments.

To request accommodations for special needs or disabilities or if you have any other questions regarding this project, please contact the Project Engineer. This includes requests relating to the Public Hearing and also requests relating to the actual operations of construction. A list of contacts for this project can be found on the enclosed fact sheet.

Project Details – Proposed Work

Street: Replace driveway aprons between the curb and new sidewalk (*sidewalk and driveway aprons are assessable*). Retaining walls or sidewalk curbs will be required in some locations to accommodate sidewalk grading. Disturbed areas will be restored with topsoil, erosion matting and grass seed, which will be watered by the contractor for the first 10 days.

Trees: There are several planned tree removals from within the Right-of-Way with this project. A list of locations are below. During construction, if any other trees must be removed, the adjacent properties will be notified prior to removal. Trees within the project limits that are to remain may be pruned and the roots may be trimmed prior to or during construction. After the project the site will be reviewed by Forestry for the potential for tree replacements. Contact the project engineer if you have questions about the reason for removal of a specific tree. Anticipated tree removals: 4001 Hiawatha Drive, 4009 Chippewa Drive, 4010 Chippewa Drive, and 4014 Cherokee Drive.

This project is eligible for a safe route grant which, if approved by the City Council, covers 50% of the cost of the sidewalk. Assessments included in this mailing do not reflect this savings.

Construction Schedule & Impacts

Tentative Construction Schedule: Early October to mid October, 2017

Traffic Impacts: Chippewa Drive will remain open to traffic throughout the project, but driveways may not be accessible at times when concrete is curing. Driveway closures may last up to 7 days. Parking may be restricted within the construction zone during working hours (7AM to 7PM), so when your driveway is not accessible, you will need to park on adjacent streets.

Refuse Collection: It will be the contractor's responsibility to allow for refuse collection during construction. Please mark your address on your cart to make sure it is returned if moved. Also collection will be done first thing in the morning, so please have your carts out before 7AM.

Landscaping: The entire right-of-way will likely be disturbed during construction. If you wish to save any existing plantings or special landscaping features, you should remove them from the right-of-way prior to the start of the work. All shrubs will be removed from the right-of-way.
