## **Standards for Variance**


The Zoning Board of Appeals shall not grant a variance unless it finds that the applicant has shown the following standards are met:


1. There are conditions unique to the property of the applicant that do not apply generally to other properties in the district.
THE LOT NARROWS FRONT TO BACK AS THE ROAD BENDS
MAKING THE BUILDABLE ENVELOPE DEPTH LESS THAN
THAT OF ADJACOUT + NEIGHBORING LOTS.
<ol> <li>The variance is not contrary to the spirit, purpose, and intent of the regulations in the zoning district and is not contrary to the public interest.</li> </ol>
THE HOUSE WOULD ALIGN WITH NEIGHBORNG HOMES
ON THE BLOCK AND DRIVE WOUND HAVE TO MEET VISION
TRIAJGLE CLEARAICE AS DETERMINED BY MARK WINTER
3. For an area (setbacks, etc) variance, compliance with the strict letter of the ordinance would unreasonably prevent use of the property for a permitted purpose or would render compliance with the ordinance unnecessarily burdensome.


