My wife Pamela and I own a condominium at The Edgewater and are avid supporters of live music and other events in the downtown area generally, and those that are held on The Edgewater's public plaza specifically.

Prior to purchasing our place at The Edgewater, we owned a condominium at The Loraine on West Washington Ave. for several years. If it's not obvious, we're bullish on the vibrancy of the downtown Madison community! We made a significant decision in choosing to sell our place at the Loraine in favor of a personally meaningful investment in our residence at The Edgewater.
