## OVERTURE'S 2018 GRANT REQUEST

Requesting the funding limit set by the Structural Agreement of \$2.193MM.

What is the derivation of the request?

Large civic performing arts centers are not able to earn enough revenue to meet their expenses much like large convention centers.

Overture like most performing arts centers is an economic catalyst that drives positive economic conditions in downtown area, but the revenue we weive is indirect.





## THE IMPACT OF ARTS ON OUR COMMUNITY

#### ARTS IMPROVE ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE

Students with an education rich in the arts have higher GPAs and standardized test scores and lower drop-out rates—benefits reaped by students regardless of socio-economic status. Students with four years of arts or music in high school average **100 POINTS HIGHER ON THE SAT** than students with just one-half year of arts or music.
