## **ACTION:**

A motion was made by Arnesen and seconded by Andrzejewski to refer consideration of the proposed demolitions at 924 E Main Street and 939 E Washington Avenue to a future meeting; and to recommend to the Plan Commission that the Landmarks Commission finds that the buildings at 501 Woodward Drive and 222 N Charter Street have historic value related to the vernacular context of Madison's built environment, but the buildings themselves are not historically, architecturally, or culturally significant, and that the buildings at 4706 E Washington Avenue and 5533 University Avenue have no known historic value.
