The City of Madison is proposing to reconstruct N. Hancock Street in 2018. Fact and Details Sheet Proposed 2018 N. Hancock Street Reconstruction

Project Details - Proposed Work

Sanitary Sewer: Replace existing main (installed in 1907) and replace laterals to the property line (assessable).

Water Main: Replace the existing water main (installed in 1916) and reconnect services to the new main.

Street: Replace the pavement and the existing curb, driveway aprons. (assessable). Drive aprons will be constructed to match the width of the driveway on private property, but will not exceed the widths allowed by ordinance.

Sidewalk will be replaced on an "as-needed" basis or to facilitate the sanitary sewer lateral replacement. (assessable).

The street widths will remain the same as the existing, but the corners will be "bumped out" at the Mifflin St intersection to facilitate pedestrian crossings.

Trees: See reverse

Street Lighting: Pedestrian scale street lighting will replace the existing street lights, the existing taller lights would remain at the intersections.

Construction Schedule & Impacts

Tentative Schedule: March or April, 2018, lasting approximately 3 months.

Traffic Impacts: N. Hancock St. will be closed to through traffic for the duration of the project. Access will be maintained to properties within the project limits, but driveway access may be prohibited for up to a total of 20 days to accommodate the removal and replacement of the curb and drive apron. There will be other times, when work is taking place in front of the driveway, when access will be limited or prohibited. This is not included in the 20 days mentioned above. The intersection of E Mifflin St will be closed to vehicular traffic, but bicycle traffic will be maintained. There will be times when bikes will need to be walked through the intersection.

Pedestrian access will be maintained on at least one side of each of the streets at all times.


Parking: On-street parking is prohibited between 7am and 7 pm within the project limits. Temporary residential parking permits will be made available, at no cost, to eligible residents within the project limits.

Water & Sewer Shut-offs: Water and sanitary sewer service will be disrupted when the old lateral is taken out of service and the new lateral is connected. A minimum of 48 hours of notice will be provided prior to the shut-offs. Each shut-off should last a few hours.

At the start of construction, the existing main will remain in service until the new main is installed and connected to; emergency shut-offs may occur if the existing main is damaged during construction.

Refuse Collection: Residents should have their trash and recycling carts at the curb by 6 a.m. If necessary, the contractor will move the carts to the closest intersection to facilitate pick-up. It will be the residents' responsibility to return the carts to their property. It is recommended that you put your address on the cart.

Grand Avenue, Mason Street, Park Place and Van Hise Avenue Forestry Comments

Tree pruning in advance of the project is required to reduce the risk of damage to the trees during construction. The City of Madison Forestry Section will perform the necessary work. For certain species, especially oak and elm trees, the pruning must be completed by April 1st to reduce the chance of disease. If trees need to be removed, City Forestry or City Engineering will notify the adjacent property owner prior to removal.

All ash street trees within the project limits have been or will be evaluated for potential chemical treatment for Emerald Ash Borer (EAB). Ash trees with trunks measuring less than 10" in diameter at 4.5 ft (DBH) from the ground, ash located under high voltage electric distribution lines, and ash that are structurally compromised or in poor condition will not be treated as outlined the City's EAB Plan. Ash trees that do not meet the treatment criteria will be removed prior to construction, and will be removed regardless of the construction project schedule. Street trees provide many benefits to our city and are considered an important part of the city's infrastructure. Forestry Section staff will evaluate the terrace for new planting sites and potential replacement sites when the project is complete. There is no additional cost to the adjacent property owner for a tree planting. Street trees are typically planted in the spring of the year following the completion of the construction project. Per Madison General Ordinance 10.10, City Forestry determines tree species and planting locations. Residents cannot choose or plant their own tree in the terrace.
