Golf Subcommittee Course of Action

1. Letter to mayor and alders expressing our thoughts about supporting city golf activities, specifically the capital needs.

2. Follow-up phone calls and communication

- 3. Appeal to Park Commission
- 4. Request to take golf out of an "Enterprise" status and move it into the rest of the park's budget. Is this a city council move? If so draft a resolution that will accomplish this.

5. Inform city decision makers of how golf finances non-golf activities.

- 6. Move to recommend that no city run golf holes be removed.
- 7. Consider re-establishing surcharge fund and take necessary steps that insure the money is used as intended (capital improvements)
- 8. Assess the capital needs of all courses and suggest a plan to address these needs.
- Continue to educate city decision makers and public about the intrinsic value of golf to the city of Madison. Explore an economic impact study.
- O. Increase fees across the board and explore charging more for courses based on use. I.E. maybe a \$1 a nine more for Odana.
