#### Zero: 2016 Goals

- Homeless Services Consortium Leadership and Board will lead effort to end homelessness for <u>130 veterans by 2015, 135 chronically homeless by 2016</u> and <u>400 families by 2017.</u>
- Will engage individuals who are experiencing homelessness or are formerly homeless, elected officials, housing and service providers, advocates, landlords, developers and funders.
- We will use coordinated entry, provide comprehensive wrap-around services, and make data driven decisions. After this is accomplished homelessness will be brief, rare and non-recurring.






