

limit excessive duplication of crafts.

Assignments: Sales areas will be assigned at the discretion of the fair

coordinator based on type of display and crafts. MOST spaces are 8'D x 9'W; hallway spaces are approximately 3'D x 14'W. Space includes two chairs - no tables. Vendor

must supply tables and extra chairs. Rental tables

available (\$5 each).

from 6:30 - 8:30 am. Please move your car to the farthest parking lot by the park shelter by 8:30 am on Saturday.
