Discontinuing and vacating a portion of the public street right-of-way of East Campus Mall, being located in the SE ¼ of the NW 1/4 of Section 23, Township 7 North, Range 9 East, City of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin. (4th AD)

WHEREAS, the public right of way of Murray Street (a.k.a. N. Murray Street), lying south of W. Dayton Street was originally dedicated by the plat of University Addition to Madison, recorded August 28th, 1850 as Document No. 109, Dane County Registry; and

WHEREAS, a portion of N. Murray Street was vacated by the City of Madison Common Council per Resolution Number 58420, File I.D. Number 29508, as adopted on June 19, 2001 and validated and made effective on July 16, 2002 with the recording of the resolution as Document No. 3514205, Dane County Registry, to permit construction of an addition to the University of Wisconsin Southeast Recreational Facility at 715 W. Dayton Street; and

WHEREAS, the City of Madison Common Council authorized the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into an agreement for the maintenance of N. Murray Street from Regent Street to W. Dayton Street per Enactment No. RES-05-00707, File I.D. 01738, as adopted on September 6, 2005 and subsequently executed by the Mayor on October 12, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the City of Madison Common Council authorized the name of N. Murray Street to be changed to East Campus Mall per Enactment No. RES-07-00867, File I.D. 06471, as adopted on September 4, 2007 and effective on June 1, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the University of Wisconsin made an application with the Department of Planning & Community & Economic Development, requesting a demolition permit and an alteration to the Planned Development (Specific Implementation Plan) for Kohl Center / LaBahn Arena / Southeast Recreational Facility to allow for the demolition and reconstruction of the Southeast Recreational Facility at 715 W Dayton Street; and

WHEREAS, the demolition permit and alteration were conditionally approved by the City of Madison Planning Commission on February 20, 2017, Legistar File No. 45529 and the said conditions of approval provided for the vacation and discontinuance of a portion of East Campus Mall to eliminate the planned fixed building canopy from protruding into a public right of way; and

WHEREAS, the City Of Madison currently does not have any public facilities within the portion of the public right-of-way to be vacated and discontinued; and

WHEREAS, the portion of the public right-of-way of East Campus Mall to be vacated and discontinued is as shown and described on the vacation and discontinuance map (Exhibit A) and legal description (Exhibit B) delineating the area to be discontinued, which are attached hereto and made part of this resolution; and

WHEREAS, this vacation and discontinuance will not result in a landlocked parcel of property; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, under Section 66.1005(2), Wisconsin Statutes, other than those easements and rights released above, any other existing easements and rights that may exist within the vacated and discontinued public right-of-way shall continue, unless as otherwise provided by statute; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, under Section 66.1005(1), Wisconsin Statutes, reversionary rights of the public right-of-ways herein vacated and discontinued shall attach to the adjacent property, currently being owned by The Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, upon Common Council adoption of this resolution, the City Engineer will then authorize the City Clerk to validate and make effective this street vacation and discontinuance by recording it with all supplemental map exhibits with the Dane County Register of Deeds, authorizing all City agencies to administer the appropriate workflows to complete and finalize all land record database updates.

The proposed resolution authorizes vacation and discontinuance of approximately 208 sq. ft. or 0.0048 acres of public street right-of-way of East Campus Mall. No appropriation is required.

WHEREAS, the public right of way of Murray Street (a.k.a. N. Murray Street), lying south of W. Dayton Street was originally dedicated by the plat of University Addition to Madison, recorded August 28th, 1850 as Document No. 109, Dane County Registry; and

WHEREAS, a portion of N. Murray Street was vacated by the City of Madison Common Council per Resolution Number 58420, File I.D. 


EXHIBIT B

EAST CAMPUS MALL VACATION AND DISCONTINUANCE Metes and Bounds Description

Part of East Campus Mall, originally platted and previously known as Murray Street (a.k.a. N. Murray Street) per the plat of University Addition to Madison, recorded as Document Number 109, Dane County Registry, also being located in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 23, Township 07 North, Range 09 East, City of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin, more fully described as follows:

Beginning at the northern most Northwest corner of Lot 1, Certified Survey Map Number 10494 as recorded in Volume 62 of Certified Survey Maps, on pages 88-93, as Document Number 3525323, Dane County Registry, also being the intersection of the south right of way line of W. Dayton Street with the easterly right of way of East Campus Mall;

thence South 01 degree 24 minutes 06 seconds West, 2.39 feet along the said east right-of-way of East Campus Mall to a point of non-tangential curvature;

thence 18.56 feet along the arc of a curve to the left, said arc also being the said east right-of-way as per a previous vacation and discontinuance of N. Murray Street recorded as Document Number 3514205, through a central angle of 53 degrees 10 minutes 00 seconds, a radius of 20.00 feet and a chord bearing South 36 degrees 19 minutes 27 seconds West, 17.90 feet;

thence South 09 degrees 44 minutes 13 seconds West along said east right-of-way and previous vacation and discontinuance, 29.32 feet;

thence North 01 degree 24 minutes 06 seconds East, 46.03 feet, along a line lying 14.50 feet west of and parallel with the original platted east right-of-way of Murray Street, to the intersection with the westerly extension of the aforementioned south right of way line of W. Dayton Street; thence South 88 degrees 47 minutes 50 seconds East along said westerly extension of south right of way line of W. Dayton Street, 14.50 feet to the Point of Beginning.

This description contains 208 square feet.
