# URBAN DESIGN COMMISSION APPROVAL PROCESS



### Introduction

The City of Madison's Urban Design Commission (UDC) has been created to:

- Encourage and promote high quality in the design of new buildings, developments, remodeling, and additions so as to maintain and improve the established standards of property values within the City.
- Foster civic pride in the beauty and nobler assets of the City, and in all other ways possible assure a functionally efficient
  and visually attractive City in the future.

### Types of Approvals

There are three types of requests considered by the UDC:

- <u>Informational Presentation</u>. Applicants may, at their discretion, request to make an Informational Presentation to the UDC prior to seeking any approvals to obtain early feedback and direction before undertaking detailed design. Applicants should provide details on the context of the site, design concept, site and building plans, and other relevant information to help the UDC understand the proposal and provide feedback. (Does not apply to CDR's or Signage Variance requests)
- <u>Initial Approval</u>. Applicants may, at their discretion, request initial approval of a proposal by presenting preliminary design information. As part of their review, the Commission will provide feedback on the design information what should be addressed at Final Approval stage.
- <u>Final Approval</u>. Applicants may request Final Approval of a proposal by presenting all final project details. Recommendations or concerns expressed by the UDC in the initial approval must be addressed at this time.

### Presentations to the Commission

Primarily, the UDC is interested in the appearance and design quality of projects. Emphasis should be given to the site plan, landscape plan, lighting plan, building elevations, exterior building materials, color scheme, and graphics.

When presenting projects to the UDC, applicants must fill out a registration slip provided in the meeting room and present it to the Secretary. Presentations should generally be limited to 5 minutes or as extended by motion by consent of the Commission. The Commission will withhold questions until the end of the presentation.

Applicants are encouraged to consider the use of various graphic presentation material including a locator map, photographs, renderings/model, scale drawings of the proposal in context with adjacent buildings/uses/signs, etc., as may be deemed appropriate to describe the project and its surroundings. Graphics should be mounted on rigid boards so that they may be easily displayed. Applicants/presenters are responsible for all presentation materials, AV equipment and easels.

# URBAN DESIGN DEVELOPMENT PLANS CHECKLIST



The items listed below are minimal application requirements for the type of approval indicated. Please note that the UDC and/or staff may require additional information in order to have a complete understanding of the project.

# 1. Informational Presentation □ Locator Map □ Letter of Intent (If the project is within a Urban Design District, a summary of how the development proposal addresses the district criteria is required) □ Contextual site information, including photographs and layout of adjacent buildings/structures □ Site Plan □ Two-dimensional (2D) images of proposed buildings or structures.

Providing additional information beyond these minimums may generate a greater level of feedback from the Commission.

### **Requirements for All Plan Sheets**

- 1. Title block
- 2. Sheet number
- 3. North arrow
- 4. Scale, both written and graphic
- 5. Date
- 6. Fully dimensioned plans, scaled at 1"= 40' or larger

\*\* All plans must be legible, including the full-sized landscape and lighting plans (if required)

In regards to the ground signs at 4 Collins Ct. (Phillips 66/Arby's), all materials are labeled "Sign A" or "Sign B".

### For Sign A:

- Sign A near the gas canopy is receiving a new Phillips 66 sign face to comply with code which requires light colored backgrounds to darken when illuminated for night viewing (see "night view" on attached shop drawings)
- Sign A will also have the overall height lowered from 29'-7" to 25' to comply with code for signs within the urban design district.

### For Sign B:

- New Phillips 66 sign face with white background to darken at night to comply with code.
- LED illuminated panel for digital numerals for "Regular" gas price
- Single color electronic message board with red copy on black background only. Applicant acknowledges that messages can only change one time every hour.

The combined square footage for both sign faces can only be a maximum of 144 per city code. Actual square footage for both is 143.83 sq. ft.

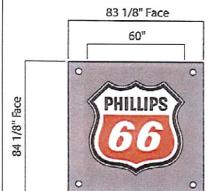

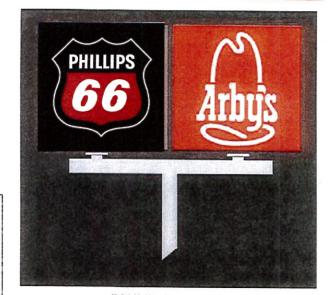




EXISTING (48.56)

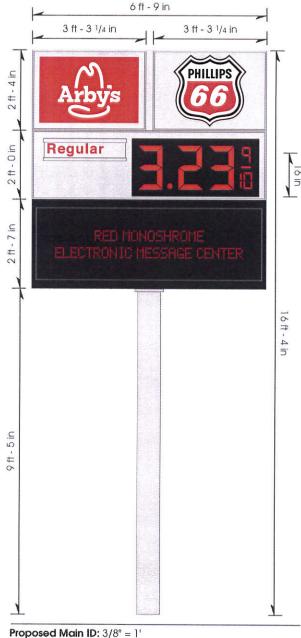

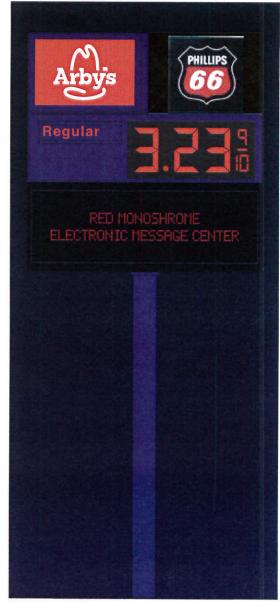
