Fiscal Note

The proposed resolution authorizes the agreement between Metro Transit and Dane County for pass-through funding in the total amount of \$267,907 in 2018 for costs associated with the State 85.21 program for accessible transportation to seniors and persons with physical disabilities as required by the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Metro will receive this funding in 2018 to directly offset costs associated with the paratransit service during the program transition from Dane County to the State's Family Care program in 2018. This resolution authorizes receipt of funding from Dane County in the amount of \$267,907, which is \$102,895 higher than the \$165,012 anticipated in Metro's 2018 executive operating budget. It is anticipated that the budgeted revenue and expense for the State 85.21 program will be updated to reflect the full \$267,907 prior to Metro Transit's 2018 budget adoption. The revenue proposed in this resolution is directly offset by costs associated with providing paratransit transportation during the phased implementation of the State Family Care which will occur from February to May of 2018.

Title

Body

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation provides State 85.21 (\$85.21 Wis. Stats.) funding to Dane County for transit services for persons who are seniors (65 years old or older) and / or persons with physical disabilities; and,

WHEREAS, each year Dane County provides the Metro Transit Utility with a portion of its 85.21 allocation to assist the Transit Utility in the operation of its paratransit services; and,

WHEREAS, funding for this program (\$85.21) provides a revenue source for Metro's ADA Paratransit Program, a service required under the federal regulation and is estimated to fund in 2018 approximately 7,916 trips for (un-specified) individuals and, *strike?*

WHEREAS, this program is an example of a model cooperative funding program to the mutual benefit of both transit and human services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and the City Clerk are authorized to enter into an agreement with Dane County to receive Specialized Transportation Assistance funding in the amount not less than \$267,907 for the provision by Metro Transit of eligible ADA paratransit program services in the Metro Transit Utility's ADA paratransit service area during the calendar year 2018.
