Dear ALRC members,

I am not able to join you at your meeting on November 15, 2017 when you will be considering an alcohol license request for Taco Bell at 534 State Street.

I remain concerned about the density of alcohol licenses on this block of State Street and associated safety issues. In discussing my concerns with the applicant and Capt Freedman, the applicant has agreed to apply for a Class B Beer and Class C Wine license only. In addition the applicant (Bob Lach) has agreed to the following conditions:

- 1. Stop serving alcohol no later than 10 pm Sunday Thursday and no later than 11 pm on Friday and Saturday.
- 2. Establishment must meet the definition of a restaurant under Section 38.02 of Madison General Ordinance at all times.
- 3. Food must be available at all times.

Given these conditions and the limited alcohol license for which the applicant has agreed to apply, I do not object to the ALRC granting the license.
