SUMMARY:

At its meeting of November 8, 2017, the Urban Design Commission **GRANTED FINAL APPROVAL** of the conversion of Number 12 Water Utility Well located at 801 South Whitney Way. Appearing on behalf of the project were Doug Hursh and Peter Holmgren, both representing Madison Water Utility. The project will convert this to a multi-well facility. Stone from other facility buildings will be used, in addition to terra cotta panel. The Water Utility wants a long-term, secure building with natural light and glass block clearstory. Some additional trees and shrubs will be added to the landscaping.

Comments and questions from the Commission were as follows:
