Board of Health for Madison and Dane County Resolution #2017–15

Resolution to Accept Funding from The Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) Division of Public Health-STD Control for Sexually Transmitted Infection Clinical Services at PHMDC.

The Sexually Transmitted Disease Control Section Director from the State of Wisconsin Public Health Division reached out to the Sexual Health team at PHMDC in November to discuss available funds for the purpose of Sexually Transmitted Infection (STI) prevention work at local health departments. We submitted a proposed budget that included medical and prevention supplies for STI prevention work.

On December 7, 2017 we received notice from the Wisconsin STD Control Section Director that PHMDC will be awarded the full amount requested, which is \$15,403. Funds will be distributed from the State through the consolidated contract.

This funding will pay for clinic equipment, an autoclave to sterilize equipment, medical supplies, STI rapid tests, and harm reduction supplies. All purchases made with this funding need to be purchased by the end of this year (2017).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Health for Madison and Dane County, on behalf of Public Health—Madison and Dane County, is authorized to enter into an agreement the Wisconsin Department of Health Services accepting \$15,403 to fund sexually transmitted infection testing, treatment, and prevention, and the director is authorized to sign the agreement.
