




I'm applying for a conditional use permit.


- #1) I'll be making Cat trees in my garage which is detached from my home. The Garage is 30ft X 18ft and is only used for making my hobbies. My garage is completely insulated for Noise reduction, & saves on energy use. (No autos are in the garage)
- #2) I work alone. (No employees)
- #3 This is more of a hobby than a job. I'd do this between the hours of 9:00 am 4:00 pm. Mon Fri. (But not every day or full days)


