A previous commitment has made it impossible for me to attend the meeting regarding the 21+ entertainment license that has been requested by Diego Enterprises for Cucos Mexican Restaurant. I am writing to have my voice be heard.

I have lived at the address for close to 30 years. During that time there have been numerous businesses at the 4426 E. Buckeye Rd address. I have financially supported all of them, including Diego Enterprises - Cucos, by being a customer. I celebrate neighborhood businesses and hope that in return they respect and appreciate the neighborhood that they reside in.

I don't feel that the current owner respects the neighborhood or the residents that live here. The noise issues cause problems for us under their current license and I shudder to think of how the problems will increase if they are granted the more permissive license. Currently the music is loud enough that when they have their karaoke events, pictures on my walls vibrate and make it impossible to have windows open that face Cucos. I am fortunate that most of the bedrooms are on the opposite side of the house, the music can be heard often times after 2am. I am not aware of any gesture, from the management, to attend neighborhood meetings or find a solution to the noise for those that are impacted. For these reasons, I strongly oppose granting the 21+ license to Diego Enterprises - Cucos Mexican Restaurant.
