RESOLUTION

Common Council (By Request of the Board of Public Works)

WHEREAS: Tree planting, landscaping, and beautification are an integral part  
of arterial and major street construction,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT,

RESOLVED: That the common Council adopts the following policy as its position  
on tree planting, landscaping, and beautification in conjunction with  
arterial and major street construction projects.

POLICY

Each arterial and major street construction or reconstruction project  
budget should as a guideline hereafter provide not less than 1-1/2% of the  
total cost of such project for tree planting, landscaping, and beautification  
efforts in addition to the normal costs of seeding or sodding. This  
provision shall apply to all phases of construction projects not yet under  
contract on the effective date of this resolution.
