EXCERPT - Madison General Ordinances

Sec. 3.35 (5) (a) 1. and 3.

(5) Standards of Conduct.

(a)

- 1. <u>Use of Office or Position</u>. No incumbent may use or attempt to use her or his position or office to obtain financial gain or anything of value or any advantage, privilege or treatment for the private benefit of herself or himself or her or his immediate family, or for an organization with which she or he is associated. This paragraph does not prohibit an incumbent from using the title or prestige of her or his office to obtain campaign contributions that are permitted and reported as required by Wis. Stat. <u>ch. 11</u>.
 - <u>Limitations on Actions</u>. Except as otherwise provided in paragraph 4, no incumbent may:
 - a. Take any official action affecting, directly or indirectly, a matter in which she or he, a member of her or his immediate family, or an organization with which she or he is associated has a financial or personal interest;
 - b. Use her or his office or position in a way that produces or assists in the production of a benefit, direct or indirect, for her or him, a member of her or his immediate family either separately or together, or an organization with which the incumbent or her or his immediate family member is associated.
